- Reference is made to the name check request, file No-A 10 459 692, subject as above, whose name you desired checked against the files of this office. The files contain the following additional information concerning Subject.
- 2. A copy of an index card from the Austrian Police Files entitled "Austrian Agent Index up to and including 1944" listed Lubowir CHYPERYJ, born 7 June 1919 in Mychalwyczi as "active for the I.S. office" in Vienna and to be "used against Russis."
- 3. Another report, dated 2 July 1960 from a reliable source states that Dr. Lybonyr ORTHONYJ was a former member of the German 26 Division in Galicia. (a German-sponsored Waffen 66 unit formed with Ukrainian personnel) He returned to Salaburg, Austria, from a Bussian PON comp at the end of World Wer II.
- b. Subject was quaried on 24 May 1961 by a reliable source concerning paragraphs 2 and 3 above. The following is his account of his activities during the time period covered in the referenced
 - a. CHYPERKY stated that in James y 1941 he was ordered by the COM (Organisation of Unvainian Maticualists) to report to the headquarters of that organization in Vienn Austria. The OUN headquarters was then under the leadership of GARRIERVICE, fms, and was concerned with the maintenance of contact between the CUE and the Abrehr. One Rittmeister

fmm RIKOJARY, at reported by CETYRERYJ, was the limison man between the OUN and the Abrehr Sektor Oct. RIKOJARY, in turn, was in contact with a Major FRETERICH of the Austrian intelligence service who was responsible to Colonel LAROSHEE, a high official of the Abvehr.

- b. CRIMENTS said that he had been sent to Vienna to organize former Unvainian prisoners of war held in Austria who had been captured as numbers of the Polish Army during the German invasion of Poland in 1939. The Old, he stated, had instructions from the Abwehr in 1941 to prepare to for military training for possible use by the German Army. These nationalist elements, he further said, were to try to break down the Soviet Army and turn Ukrainian elements into anti-Soviet allies. The leadership of the CON and MINOJARY developed this doctrine and compiled personality lists along see lines. ORTHEKIJ reported that this was kept highly secret by the Abselu and kept from the Gestapo, the AD (Security Service) and the REDAP. (Mational Socialist German Worker's Perty)
- e. The progrem mentioned above eventually recruited about three to few hundred Ukrainians who were organized into military unit teams. These teams, using Slovak uniforms and Ubrainain insignia, CHYPERIS said, were sent to Russnia, and began political and propaganta work with the Ukrainian population as soon as the German-Seviet war began. However, suddenly in August 1941, NAMERIA, the leader of the OUN was arrested by the Germans and the Ukrainian units were ordered back to Austria, disarsed by the Gersen Army and all members taken prisoner. CETYERYJ stated that the Abwehr, although realizing the stupidity of this act, was helplass.
- d. CETTERIJ reported that the arrested Ukrainians were released in September 1941 and he, himself, was sent by the Old with Absobr help as a courier to Berlingto report to MANDEA. He said he returned from this mission on 14 Septem 1941, but, on his arrival in Vienna, he was arrested by the destape and imprisoned for a year. The Abselu could do nothing at this time to effect his release. At the end of one year, CHINEXI said, he was released and returned to Vienna to study He fled Vienna in 1943 to avoid a new mass arrest and returned to Breslau where he was hidden by OHE numbers. CHYCHERYJ stated that it was in Breslau that he received orders from his OUH superior, Major PIDEAINY, to join the Ukrainian Waffen 88 division, "Galitsia."
