On 30 May 1989, Chuck Boles, Department of State DS/CI, telephoned C/SAD to relate that State has no record on on the 1951 investigation in which Kronthal, and three other Agency employees, were alleged to have been determined to have been homosexual. Boles speculated that the file material had been destroyed.
