SUBJECT: Alexandre SHABASHEFF

1. At the request of the American Consulate in Buenos Aires we checked the above mentioned Subject with the Belgian Services and the following information is the result of an investigation by the 2e Direction.
2. SHABASHEFF is the object of a secret dossier at the Sureté de l'Etat. He arrived in Belgium in 1935. An archpriest of the Russian church, he was attached to the Russian Archbishop of Berlin before the war, and represented the Eastern countries. During the enemy occupation of Belgium he collaborated with the Germans and worked in full agreement with POLOSKI, member of the Gestapo. Subject is responsible for the arrest by the Germans of the Archbishop ALEXANDRE. He was known to the Sureté de l'Etat and realizing that his arrest was only a matter of days, he fled from the country, aided by influential members of his church. He is reported presently to be in Argentina. He was also a close contact of KOWSKI, who was the pro-German director of the Russian colony in Belgium during the occupation.
3. For your information Subject was in close touch with General HARTMANN and General ARCHANGELSKY.
