The following consists of three items submitted by unevaluated sources reporting from widely separated areas.

Of the 700 terman officers formed into a General Staff under Generals Faulus and von Seydlitz at Detakoe Selo, about 100 were sent to Soviet military formations in January 1946. Treatment, pay, accompdations and rations were almost as good as those accorded Russian officers.

Field Commont: The Beauty Seydlitz headquarters were located at betskoe Selo, south of Loningrad. This German Officers' Union controlled approximately 100,000 German PWs located in camps at Kalininsk (Petrozavodsk), Sestroretsk, Wrasnoi, Yalta, Rasseby, Leminsky (Peterhof; for GAP personnel).



1. The German officer's Union, under the guidance of Generals Paulus and SEYDITZ, was transformed at the end of 1945 into a center for political and military study with its headquarters located at Detskoe Selo, south of Leningrad.

2. This organization controls about 100,000 German PW in Russia, who are located at the following training camps:

Detskoe Selo
Leninsky (Peterhof) (For mir Corps personnel)
Kalininsk (Petrozavodsk)
Sestroretsk
Krasnoi
Krasncarmeisk (Yalta)
Rassebv (probably)

3. A General Staff, consisting of about 700 German officers, was formed at Detskoe Selo at the beginning of 1946. Of these about 100 were sent to Russian military formations in January 1946. Treatment, pay, accomadations, and rations are almost as good as for the Russian officer counterpart.
