SYNOPSIS OR BRIEF REPORT:

- On December 28th, the reported war criminal ULMGAY, former SS Gruppenführer and commander of a Caucasian SS Division, was scheduled to leave Italy for Chili together with his family and his mistress, Vera Kiriozna NAPEGKO, alias TVERSKO, alias BELOMESTOVA, alias ULMGAY.
- ULMGAY, of Tcherkess origin, was a White Russian officer after World War I and fought against the Red Army. He helped King ZOG to return to power in Albania and was subsequently nominated by ZOG to be a Colonel in ZOG's "Garde de Corps". In 1945 ULMGAY went secretly to Rome. In 1946, ULMGAY, together with his wife and children, were given permission by a certain Father Philippe de Régis S.J. to live at Via Tasso 155 in a refugees' home, which had been organized by the Vatican and the Pontifical College "Russicum". Father Philippe delayed ULMGAY's admittance to the home for some time because of ULMGAY's immorality and drunkenness.
- Vera Kiriozna NAPEGKO, ULMGAY's mistress, was born in Odessa. After World War I she went to Serbia, where she later worked for the Nazis. While there, she married a certain Mr. IVERSKO, but was later divorced. She holds two false passports, one in the name of ULMGAY, the other in the name of Miss BELOMESTOVA. One of the passports is Albanian. Father TUCHARRY, Secretary of the Immigration Section of the Pontifical Assistance Commission in Rome was asked to procure permission for the ULMGAY family and their "sister" NAPEGKO-ULMGAY-BELOMESTOVA to travel to Argentina. Father TUCHARRY, who was unaware of the fraud, is reported to have succeeded in obtaining passage on a steamer leaving Genoa on December 27th or 28th, 1946.
