SYNOPSIS OR BRIEF REPORT:

1. The Swiss Federal Police have asked us if we know the addresses of the persons listed below. The Federal Police have asked that if these persons could be found, that they be allowed to interrogate them if they are available.

a. EHINGER, Otto: German, born 10 April 1886. As a Lieutenant Colonel, he was former head of Abt III and Referat III P, Ast Dijon. He ran a Swiss national as an agent against Switzerland.

b. NAUBER, Heinrich: Alias BERTRAND, Henri; alias HUBER, Erich. Born in Lausanne 19 December 1909. A German subject. Architect by profession. Probably living in Westphalia. NAUBER left Lausanne early in 1943 to enter the Gestapo in Germany. Worked as Gestapo agent and for Ast Dijon from 1943 until the end of the war. He reported military intelligence concerning Switzerland to the Germans.

c. DAUFELDT, Hans: Born 20 January 1908 at Kappeln. Recalled to Germany in December 1944 at request of the Swiss Foreign Office.

d. Von BIBRA, Sigismund: Born 3 June 1894 at Oberems. At present believed to be in US custody in Ludwigsburg.

e. GLAESER, Josef: Born 22 September 1904.

Italy f. GEILER, Alfred Josef: Born 22 April 1899 at Thalwil, Switzerland. A German subject. Expelled from Switzerland. Formerly Obersekretär der Deutschen Reichsbahn in Basel. Possibly in US custody in Italy.
