**Tirana:** Tanjug correspondent reports that the following communique was issued last night in Tirana: On August 8 and 9, Greek planes flew over the bay in the littoral zone of Kimara and Karanda and over several places in the region of Argyrokastron. On August 8, at 15:00 hours, a Greek three-motor plane, coming from the westerly direction, flew over the Albanian seacoast in the direction of Karanda. The plane flew at an altitude of 2000 meters and disappeared in the direction of ... On August 9, at 11:00 hours, a Greek plane flew at an altitude of 1500 meters over the region of Kimada and ... then disappeared in the direction of Greece. On the same day, 25 minutes later, another Greek three-motor plane, coming from the west, flew over the city of Argyrokastron. After the anti-aircraft fire was opened the plane was forced to withdraw in the direction of Greece. The plane flew at an altitude of 2500 meters.

**BULGARIAN NEWS AGENCY DENIES GREEK ACCUSATION OF BULGARIAN TROOP CONCENTRATION ALONG FRONTIER**

**Sofia:** The Bulgarian Telegraph Agency has issued an official communique in connection with a Greek newspaper agency report transmitted by Agence France Presse and Reuter on August 10 concerning a statement made by General Manidakis, spokesman of the Greek General Staff, on alleged movements of Bulgarian troops on the Bulgaro-Yugoslav frontier and concentration of same along the Greek frontier. The communique states:

"The Bulgarian Telegraph Agency is authorized to state that no movement of Bulgarian troops along the southern frontier, where it is impossible to take units from the western frontier which is guarded by a most limited number of Bulgarian soldiers doing frontier guard duty, are taking place. This report, fully invented by the Greek news agency, represents part of the well known and long applied slanderous campaign which aims at causing unrest among peoples and doubt in Bulgaria's intentions toward her southern neighbor. Furthermore, the Bulgarian Telegraph Agency is authorized to deny most categorically the report transmitted by Reuter agency of August 10th of this year from Athens, concerning the alleged crossing by ... armed band of the Greco-Bulgarian frontier in the northern direction in the region of Alogos, near the river of Struma, on the East of Macedonia ...

SECOND GROUP OF YUGOSLAV-CANADIANS RETURN HOME

Belgrade: The second group of our emigrants returning home from Canada is due to leave today Montreal onboard our transatlantic ship "Radnik". This is the second transport of our emigrants in the course of the two last months. The group numbers 422 persons, mostly miners, factory and agricultural workers. Among them are also highly skilled workers, technicians, and experts in foundry work. Like the first group of our emigrants who returned from Canada, this group also brings with it various machinery and installations valued at about half a million dollars. Our repatriates from Canada bring this time also a large number of gifts for their native land and towns. After their arrival in the country where a warm brotherly reception is being prepared for them, our repatriates from Canada will be given work in large mining enterprises, factories and agricultural estates. They will apply their many years experience in the work on the reconstruction of their fatherland. It is expected that the SS Radnik will arrive in Fiume by the end of this month whereupon it will immediately leave for Canada to bring the third largest group of our Canadian emigrants.

GREEK POLICY AND AMERICANS IN GREECE

The entire world sees now that the so-called American aid to Greece has brought about a further sharpening of internal political crisis of the country. The civil war increases in intensity. The Greek people fight ever harder against the monarchofascist Reaction which has become a weapon in the hands of foreign powers. The Greek Government press now writes ever less frequently that the Americans went to Greece so they could help the country to weather the difficulties of the economic rehabilitation. In the first place, the task is to establish the order in the country under the American direction. The credits, extended by the American Congress for the pretended aims of the economic rehabilitation of Greece, must realize the military program worked out by the American experts. This program foresees that Greece be transformed into a bridgehead of the American expansionists in the Balkans, into a base of military operations. New roads are being constructed toward the Greco-Yugoslav and Greco-Albanian frontiers. In the Yanina zone and at other points of the Albanian-Yugoslav frontier airdromes are being built. The American military mission took over the reorganization of the Greek Army which is supplied with American arms. On August 9, the Greek Government handed a memorandum to the American Ambassador to Athens and to the Chief of the American military mission in Greece. The memorandum has been also given to the British Charge d'Affaires. The Greek press reports its contents. From it can be seen that the Greek Government army cannot oppose the partisans. The memorandum provides for further increase of the army's contingents, which are composed at present of 120,000 men, as well as of its supplies of modern technical means with the aim of increasing the power of its fire. Beside there is foreseen the creation of regular units for self-defence, composed of government's followers. The Greek Government, says the memorandum, appeals to its Allies, the USA and Great Britain, for a quick and substantial help. The Greek memorandum, drafted following a conference of the government members and representatives of the USA in Athens, is an official confirmation that now are being worked out plans for a decisive step. In fact, the US is already financing the preparation for this intervention. The following problem remained unsolved: whose troops will have to help the Greek government troops, if British units evacuate Greece? The Americans are proposing to the Greek Government to conclude an agreement with Turkey for the sending of Turkish troops to Greece. This plan has not been enthusiastically greeted by Greek leading circles when it resulted that Turkey, as compensation for the given help, would claim some territories. Now they are working on a new project: They intend to form some volunteers detachments

composed of German Nazis of the American occupation zone in Germany as well as of Italy's and of Poland's, Indian and other quislings. These detachments are to be concentrated in the Italian ports wherefrom they would be sent to Greece to fight against the partisans. The concentration of the international fascist rascals for the stifling of Greek democracy is a plan really worthy of the present dollar diplomacy, and it is contrary to the most elementary principles of justice. The initiators of this plan, attempting to justify their meddling in the internal affairs of Greece, are spreading false reports according to which the partisans would receive help from abroad. This crude falsehood has already been disproved many times by numerous data. Additional data is being collected by the correspondent of the American agency Associated Press. Delius, together with a camera-man, made a tour in the Macedonian zones of Yugoslavia which border with Greece. He did not find anything which would approach the picture given by the false news ... by the Greek Fascists according to which there would be a mobilization and other reparations of military character in Yugoslavia. What we have seen was the picture of a peaceful development. The Allied military representatives, too, who recently visited this zone, inform that they did not find anything which would prove that Macedonia ... (has been invaded). The American Government hardly succeeded in persuading the Congress to allocate for the realization of the Greco-Turkish program ... This was an attempt to convince the American contributors that the credits would be assigned to the reestablishment (of peace and democracy) in Greece... Every American, as ignorant in politics as can possibly be, cannot fail to see that the project of sending to Greece, disguised as volunteers, some SS-men and similar Fascists, dressed in American uniforms. The fact that the Greek reactionaries and their American protectors give evidence of great hurry in the realization of their new designs is very significant. According to the writing of the American paper POST MERIDIEM, it is difficult that Truman could expect the support of the people after having recognized ... that the actual problem consists in liquidating a sufficient number of Greeks in order to compel the remainder to reconcile in silence with the present regime. This is the reason why the Greek Government flooded the world with false declarations about the northern neighbors of Greece. This is the reason, points out the POST MERIDIEM, why the Greek Government is in hurry to receive the American aid before its deceit be unmasked. The American policy in Greece threatens the peace in the Balkans. The support and encouragement of the monarchofascist reaction helped with the dollars prolongs the civil war, and is a source of new sufferings to the Greek people. The events in Greece are an example which should alarm all those who believe in the disinterestedness and philanthropy of the so-called Marshall plan, which is a new edition of the Truman doctrine.
