SPIRIDOVIECH, Alexandre

1. Alexandre SPIRIDOVITCH was born 5 August 1873 in St- Petersburg, Russia. His present address is 33 rue de la Tourelle, Boulogne.

2. The following data is given as background information on subject and the group of Russians with which he was connected. A vast organisation spread throughout Europe under the Ritley regime was headed by a Russian named Royle ROPPER. He operated from Helsingfors, and in France this service was represented by SPIRIDOVITCH, living in Paris, who had previously directed the Imperial Russian Police. SPIRIDOVITCH collaborated with Boris TORDLI who represented the "Weltdienst" in Switzerland which was under the direction of Colenel Ulrich FLEISCHHAUER in Erfurt.

SPIRIDOVITCH's mistress for a long time was a certain ROMATING - who married a certain NEMIROVITCH-DAMCHENKO (editor of "Russia Illustree" and "Russiasanse"). Shortly after the marriage they went to Berlin where they were in close contact with Alfred ROMENBERG. SPIRIDOVITCH was in contact with them at this time.

3. In Holland the POPPER organisation was represented by a certain Dr. LOUSITZKE who corresponded through the following letter boxes: a) WEL. ED. Hear Spiero, Pijbosestwest 21, Den Haag- b) Contesse A. TOLSTOI, Sweelinekstwest 51, Den Haag. (Paris, 5 January 1939).

i. The fellowing is a list of the men connected with the organization and pertinent information concerning them:

Boris POFPER - Russian - German Agent. Headed a vast organisation spread throughout Europe under the guidance of the Hitler regime. Centre of activity: Brussels. In Helsingfors, January 1939. Operated principally in France, Belgium and Finland. Had two elose cellaborators: Hisclas KOTLLARENSKY (born 20.10.1890 in Pelteva, Russia) and Hiselas DOUBERSKY (born 24.2.1893 in Petrograd, Russia).

KOTLIARENSKY

KOTLIAREWSKY, Nicolas - Russian. Born 20.10.1890 in Poltava, Russia of Michel and RODZIANKO. Married 30/1/1921 in Belgrade to Countess Monssimi - Pousckine, Barbe, born 30/1/1897 in St-Petersurg. Former secretary of General WRANGEL, arrived in Paris with him on 28/6/1925. Left 20/7/1925 for Brassels. Returned with the General from 10/5/1926 to 19/6/1926.

DOUBENSKY, Micolas born 21/2/1893 in Petrograd, Russia of Daitri and Vere Hulling. Refugee. Married 5/2/1918 in Hoseow Liamina, Elizabeth born 13/11/1896 in Moseow, of Simon and Helene Polementoff. Divorced. One daughter: Helene, bern 21/6/1929 in Malta, English national, Hives with mether in Helgium. Arrived France from Italy 13/2/1920, Russian passport # h delivered in Rese 15/1/1920. Resided at

Stated he stayed at Hotel de Chambery (7 rue Brey, 17e) when in Paris but really stayed with cousin Serge TVERSKOY, 195 rue 3t—Deminique, Paris. President of "Russe Blanes" dit "Parti Fasciste Russe". Headquarters at his home 16 rue Gachard, Brussels. Would like to set up new regime in Russia with German help. His organisations V.P.F. worked with the Gestape, would furnish anti-Bolshevik appy. He worked with:

Boris TOEDLI, born 7/5/1901 or 1896 in Kiev — Swiss national — worked German propagands service, Weldienst, Erfurt. Accused espionage in Switserland and condemned "in absentia" in April 1938 to 3 months imprisonment by Bern Tribunal.

ROMANOV, Antony

Principal agent in France. Address: Plessis-Hobinson (Seine)

AREHAMBRICKT or AREHAMBURISKI, General - born 1882 in Petrograd.

Connected with DOUBENSKY. Chief of Russian Hilitary Union in Brussels. 366 rue Vanderkinden, Brussels. President of "Federation Generale des Associations d'Ansiena Generale des Associations d'Ansiena Generale Russels abrend. Was to contact Dubs Andre Viadimir to crientate new policy in face of grents (1939).

HANDSCHEMENT, Serge born in Petrograd 25/8/1963. 619 Avenue Bruckman, Brussels. Accused 16/1/1939 of espionage. Held Cherche-Midi prison, admitted connection with DOUBENSKY. In contact with GIS, gave information on French defenses.

SPIRIDOVITCH, Alexandre -Russian born in Petregred on 5/8/1873 of Jean and Anne Flichevsky. Married 19 October 1915 in Messew to Marguerite TEMBURSKY, born in Moscow 20/3/1889. Separated. Arrived from Constantinople (after many visits before the war) on 19/2/1920. Since July 1937 he has lived at 33 rue de la Tourelle, Boulogne Billancourt. 1933 -1937 7 rue du Commandant Guilbaud, Boulogne Billancourt. Lived with RODZIANKO, nee HESKETH Nins. Had as secretary....

unidentified Pierre Faure - French. Former member of the DODIA, and a General, he was for many years Chief of the Caar's Secret Police. Wrote in Paris: "L'Histoire du Terrorisme Russe" (1896-1917). Member of Russian monarchist movement in Paris - at one point he was suspected of furnishing information to the Bolsheviks but this could not be proved. In June 1938 he gave lectures at the "Foyer Russe" on revolutionary movement in ancient Russia. Reported as agent in France of FLEISCHAUER during the TOEDLI trial in Bern. This information adds to Suspicion of Subject, and ties him up with Boris POPPER. While working for Hemirovitch-Dantschenko, lecated at his rus Franceis Gerard, Paris 16s, he sent Russian emigrants to Germany.

TUERSKOT, Serge was born 18/5/1871 in Mescow. Son of Daitri and Marie Protessef. Married Mathalie RODZEVITCH (Born in Ayasan, Russia) in Mesone 30/9/1908. He has two daughters: Marie, born 22/5/1969 in Dufa and Nine born in Moscow 2h/8/1911. Lives gince 1928 at 125 rue Saint Dominique, Paris. For ten years (1929-1939) he has not received any salary, lives on money from his daughters and from Alexandre LODIGENSKY. President of "Nouvement Chrotien National Basse", in Geneva, living at Saint Julian, Genevoix, (H.S.). TUERSKOY was to work in 1939 with "La Mouvelle Yole" newspaper. "Procureur de Moscou" until 1915 - Governor of the Province of Saratoff until 1917. Chief of civil government under Campial WRANGEL. Resided in Belgrade and Berlin, and then came to France. Investigated by French because he was Secretary General of the "Rocieto Historique and Geneelogique Resser in France. Member of the Association des Anciens Megistrats Busses" &3 rue de Crimes, of "Association des Russes, Paris. For a few years, until 1938, he was Assistant Editor of the magazine "Russie Illustree" 17 rue de la Trempille. He was named Chief of the Russian Information Service of the MSDAP, in Berlin. Office 43 rue Francois Gerard, Paris los. Sends Russian emigrants to Germany.

M. FRRMAN - 30-35 years old (1938) married to a certain PRANBERGER.
Himmler representative to conduct work among Russians. German refugee
in Paris. Chief is Boris POPPER.

MENIROVITCH-DANTSCHEMEO, Georges born 2h/7/1889 in Saint Petersburg.

Married Anne Ondianska in Munich October 1938. Lived 6 years, 15 rue
de Paris, Cliehy. From 1938 on he lived h3 Avenue Victor Huge, Boulegne
/s/Seine. Former Press Chief of WRANGEL Army. Member of Association
des Ecrivains et Journalistes Anciens Eleves de l'Esole de Dreit de
St. Petersburg*, 9 rue de Chavaleilles.

RONANOW, Antomy, bern 15/7/1896 in Petrograd. Married 20/2/192k in Belisce, Jugoslavia, Mathalie THILLOT bern 28/7/1899 in Petrograd. Lives 9 Avenue Payret Dortail, Plessis Robinson (Seine). Contacted DOUBENSET when he came to Paris in September 1938 in the Russian Church, rue Daru.
