MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: OSTROWSKI, Boleslaw

1. A review of the files of CGO-CIA disclosed no pertinent identifiable information concerning the subject of your inquiry. However, one report, which was not evaluated at the time and which also may have been prepared by a political opponent of the subject, stated that in 1944, pro-communist Polessewian circles in Poland acquired the services of a German collaborator by the name of Boleslaw OSTROWSKI. He was reportedly an active Polessewian politician in Poland from 1944 to 1947, associating with pro-Soviet elements or groups. He was eventually transferred to Leda, Poland, the last permanent address given. At the time of the report, which was August 1949, he was appointed chairman of the Central Polessewian Council by the Germans in Leda.
