MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: OSTROWSKI, Radoslaw

1. A review of the files of OSD-CIA discloses no pertinent identifiable information concerning the subject of your inquiry. However, one report, which was not evaluated at the time and which also may have been prepared by a political opponent of the subject, stated that in 1944, pre-communist Polish circles in Poland acquired the services of a German collaborator by the name of Radoslaw OSTROWSKI. He was reportedly an active Polish politician in Poland from 1934 to 1937, associating with pro-Soviet elements or groups. He was eventually transferred to Lodz, Poland, the last permanent address given. At the time of the report, which was August 1949, he was appointed chairman of the Central Polish Council by the Germans in Lodz.
