1. There are no definite traces in POB files of any of the persons you mention in your note on Radoslaw OSTROJSKY, et al. Listed below are some vague possibilities.
2. One OSTROWSKI, Inu, is described merely as chief of the white-Russian group in West Germany which is opposed by the KRIWITSCHI group led by ABRAMTSCHIK, a white-Russian living in Paris. We assume this card entry refers to the person you have in mind, as we notice this fragmentary information is confirmed in attachment to MGKA-21381, dated 4 August 1950, pages 86-91, which MOB received.
3. We have a card entry on one POPKOW, Ivan, alias KORDIENKO, stating merely that he is on the CIC Blacklist and has a criminal record. The information is from CIC and dated 6 September 1950. Presumably more is available from CIC.
4. A carded notation states that one Ludwik GOLUBOVICH, born 17 May 1915 in Minsk, was described in HICOG report 2602, dated 27 March 1952, but unfortunately the report itself is no longer available to us.
5. One Georg (Jurek) HOLUBOWICZ (a common variation of GOLUBOVICH), a lawyer born 22 June 1913 in Tarnopol (Ukrainian rather than Belorussian), is a former ZIPPER agent living in Salzburg, at last report, and working for USFA or CIC. We doubt that he is identical with the person you have in mind.
6. We have asked for ZIPPER traces.
