Subject: Derogatory Information on Radzisz GERSHANSKI

1. A report, unavaluted, and which may have been prepared by a political opponent of the Subject, stated that in 1944 pro-communist circles in Poland acquired the services of a German collaborator by the name of Radzisz GERSHANSKI. He was reportedly an active Polish-Russian politician in Poland from 1924 to 1927, associating with pro-Soviet elements or groups. He was eventually transferred to Lodz, Poland, the last permanent address given. At the time of the report, which was August 1949, he was appointed Chairman of the Central Polish-Russian Council by the Germans in Lodz.

2. This unavaluted report states that GERSHANSKI in:

1924-27 - Active with pro-Soviet groups in Poland.

1926 - Employed as Director of High School in Wilno for financial misconduct.

1943-45 - Collaborated with the Germans, becoming Chairman of the Central Polish-Russian Council.

1945 - Dissolved this Council.

1948 - Reconstituted Council without legal foundation in March 1948.
