

OTTO, Hans

State Department records, checked 6 November 1951 in the name of subject, reflected $a_{\rm S}$ follows:

"The name of one Hans ____ referenced to dispatch to Stuttgart dated 10 March 50 indicating visa refused; copy furnished FbI & CIA."

"There was no further information relative to subject; identity of the above individual with subject could not be established."

The riles of CIA contain the rollowing information:

"A report dated 23 December 1948 reflects the folling in reference to one Hans _____. Housekeeper for Berliner-Rundfunk officers mass. Russian informant. In 1947 lived in Berlin-Pankow, Carmen-Sylvastr.

"Age (1948) approx 32 Height 167 C.M.; dark hair, brown eyes, oval race."

of the Russian desk OSO, provided the rollowing of one of the same hame as the subject:"

"Hans _____ 'as an associate of a cheirman working for the Russian IS and he was connected with the Soviet-inspired kidnap attempt on an official of an anti-Soviet emigre organization."

"The secretary of one Hans _____, Giselia Hetler, was also allegedly working for the Russian Intelligence Service."

"A report dated 29 September 1944 reflects a Hans ___ was a pronazi of Reichenback on den Fils (; miles from Uningen), reportedly was an early ardent Nazi and was one of the first to lend trucks for party meetings. He owned the greater part of the family spinning and weaving mills and neld some position in the industrial organization of the party."

"A report dated 20 April 50 states one Hans _____ (procurement of material) is listed as one of the important personnel or the organization committee of the FUJ Deutschlandtrellen".
