I received your letter of the 7 October last week, Herr

Edgip is in here at the present; I will meet him next
week.

Immediately after receiving your letter I talked with WABER
and he was willing to help you. The latter had the opportunity
to talk with WABER III and he assured us that he will look you
up and help you. We have complete sympathy for your difficulties
but we must wait until the Commercial Director (Handelsdirektor),
the assistant, that is the gentleman with whom we had the
agreement to work with in regard to the freedom of movement at all
points in the world has set some conditions. He is doing all that
he can to help you. The Handelsdirektor on the other hand has
not yet decided if he will help you directly or indirectly; either he
will help you or he will not.

I am sure WABER III will be Edgip have forgotten
nothing about it and he will be able to fight against such
torture. We hope that in spite of all our efforts we have not
been successful in weakening the opposition.

I am writing you a short and formal note because I
cannot find any other way to reach you. You should try to find
a means of sending your letter, which has been transmitted here rapidly
