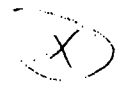

1. Subject is, at present, reported to be in Rome. He has sent word to Enrico KRAMER, by Capt. BUSTELLI of the Swiss Police, that he (~~PARRILLI~~) was responsible for KRAMER's arrest by the Germans but that he was forced to take this step. He has asked for an interview with KRAMER to explain. KRAMER has answered that this explanation would only be acceptable if it were presented in writing.
