SUBJECT: Baron Luigi PARRILLI, Questionnaire

NOTE: The following statements are those on which full and complete details are desired in the interest of clarifying this case. They are not to be interpreted in a restricted sense; full details are required on all activities bearing on the points covered; when there is any doubt, a lengthy discussion rather than a brief treatment should be the rule.

1. All details on Fascist Party background, if any. This includes date of Party membership, participation in PNF activities, relations with the prominent Fascist leaders, etc. Specifically, it is desired to know the details of subject's alleged contacts with Achille STARACE.

2. What was subject's specific activity at the outbreak of, and during, the war to September 1943? What were his German contacts during this period: who?, how formed?, nature of relationships?

3. What contacts did subject have with the German Embassy, Rome: who?, how formed?, nature and scope of relationships? Did subject at any time have contact with KAPPLER, KOEHLER, FRIEBKE, et al in Rome, or elsewhere? If so, full details?

4. Nature of contacts with the Baroness Gunhilde THYSSEN, nee von FABRICE.

5. All details on contact, if any, with Hans Wilhelm EGEN.

6. Subject's contacts with, and activities of, Dante TUNINUTTI.

7. All details on background and issuance, 5 Nov. 1943, of arms permit to subject by EINSATZKDC Rome, B&S ITALIEN.

8. Reasons for and persons contacted during subject's trip to Rumania in August 1943. Was this trip facilitated in any way by German authorities? If so, by whom? and why?

9. Full details, preferably in chronological succession, of the contacts between subject (and his wife) with Major ENGELS, Genoa. This should cover such points as: when and how did the contact begin?, why and on what basis did it continue?, with whom else in ENGELS' suite was subject in contact?, what was the frequency of contacts?, of telephone calls?

Did subject ever discuss with ENGELS' conditions and personalities of the Republican forces? or any other topic of political content? What favors, personal or otherwise, did ENGELS bestow on subject in return for subject's hospitality and indulgence? When was the last time, and under what circumstances, that subject saw, heard or talked with ENGELS? What does subject know of the arrest in Genoa of Luigi TRISTANO & Dottile, Aldo & ANTESI & Maria Giovanna and Alberto ELANDI & Falco by ARO Genoa, June-September 1944?

10. Subject is asked to explain in detail his contacts in Genoa with the following: Maurizio MORRIS, Piero ZICCARDI & Zucca, Admiral FRACCO, and Vero ROBERTI. Specifically, subject is asked to explain his possession at the end of 1943 of some 12 w/t sets, which he had agreed to pass to VESPA. Why were these sets never passed?

11. What were subject's contacts with ZICCARDI & Bruni & DAD & Zucca, after the arrest of TRISTANO, named above? What does subject know of the activities of Raffaele DI DONATO? What does subject know of ZICCARDI's arrest in Milan, August 1944?

12. Full details on contacts with following: Ugo CSTERLA & Dr. Ugo, Valerio BENEZZI, Andrea ZOLYGLY & Bandy, Don BICCHIERAI.

13. Full details on contact with Maurizio RICCIULLI & Moro, following arrest of ZICCARDI. Why was not ZICCARDI released on 10 October 1944, as subject is alleged to have assured RICCIULLI on 20 September? Full details on subject's attempt to secure false documents for ZILBER through RICCIULLI. What was the nature of the arrangement between subject and RICCIULLI for these documents? How did SAEVECKE discover that ZILBER was involved in this deal? Where did subject secure the false Todt document which he provided for RICCIULLI on 6 September? Subject guaranteed to SAEVECKE, then Ettore DAD, the name under which ZICCARDI was arrested on 24 August 1944, was bona fide and known to him; how did he justify this step when ZICCARDI was forced under duress a month later to admit his real identity?

14. Full details on contacts with RUK, Milan. Was subject in contact with any other German economic or industrial office in Milan?

15. What is subject's version of the arrest of CRIVELLI and what part did he play in the arrest of Lt. Enrico CRALLER, 15 January 1945? Full details are desired on the connection of Eduardo POSS with this affair. Who contacted CRALLER for the first time?, what were the circumstances of the arrest? etc. Has subject since the armistice sent word to CRALLER, via Capt. BUSTELLI of the Swiss police, admitting that he was responsible for CRALLER's arrest? If so, full details.

16. Did subject or his wife ever receive money, either in currency or check, from the EDS Italian? What was the nature of the revelations between subject and his wife and Dr. and Mrs. G. VALLO? Did subject receive gasoline, oil or any other form of gift or favor, direct or indirect, from SD officials in Milan or Genoa or from any German official?

17. When did subject first talk with DOLLMANN on the possibility of peace negotiations? under what circumstances? on whose initiative? With what Germans was subject in contact regarding the negotiations? Full details are requested on subject's meetings and conversations with the German IS and Army officials, from February to April 1945. What is the relation of the activities of PRAGER on behalf of the Germans in October 1944 and subject's activities in February 1945?

18. Full details on contacts, if any, with the following:

21. What do you know of Prince von FURSTENBERG? Same questions as for (1).

22. Give as detailed a biography as you can of General LEYERS, of the R.U.K.

23. Please provide what biographical details you can on:

a) Mrs. Josefina PO ... (?) Where does she live? What were the relations between her and General SCHELLENBERG?

b) Who is Emilie PO..., husband of the above? Does he live in Bergamo, where he has a silk factory?

c) Where does Giorgio P., the brother of Emilie PO..., live?

d) Do you know of a Count POLLI? Details.

24. What encounters did you have in Milan or elsewhere with Rittmeister Ferdinand THUN? with Hauptsturmführer SAVECKE?

25. What were your relations with Galiardo de Pohl, of Galliate? Why did you introduce him to Lt. ZILLER?

26. Just what approaches did Count Eduard BCSS make to Lt. ZILLER pertaining to working for the German cause? Did ZILLER or BCSS ask you to introduce them to one another? How did it come about that these two met through you?

27. Just what influence did the Japanese Ambassador use to get you a passport in the Switzerland? When? How many contacts did you have with him?
