1. Ing. SIDAK: NO 201

One of the inmates of the MURNAU-camp is a certain Ing. SIDAK, who is one of the chief agents of the "PRCHALA-Movement" in the U.S.S.R. Zone of Germany. He entertains correspondence with General PRCHALA in LONDON and with his son in the ARGENTINE. He is also acting as courier between the PRCHALA-Movement and Czechoslovakia. He last visited Czechoslovakia at the beginning of February.

2. MUC. Vladimir PERELSKY:

DOB: CIR 19

The chief representative of the "PRCHALA-Movement" in Germany is MUC. Vladimir PERELSKY. His age is about 30. His father, a medical practitioner in BRNO, was a leading functionary of the "VLAJKA" during the war. In 1945, he was shot by the Russians, without being convicted by a Court. Since that time, PERELSKY is living in Germany.

He has a fashionable office in MUNICH, Schenerstrasse 6, room #7. There he works with his lady-secretary and with a certain architect from BRNO. He receives his mail to the following address: MUNICHEN 9 - Postfach.

He has considerable financial funds at his disposal.
