(b)(1) (b)(3)	Japanese press stories of threats by Aum Shinrikyo to US facilities or President Clinton are speculation and do not appear to be supported by hard information. For example, an article in Shukan Gendai claims that "the cult reportedly had secretly put together a plan to assassinate US President Clinton come what may." Among the "evidence" cited to support this claim is a reference to security countermeasures in Washington, with the inference being made that US agencies believed Aum followers were planning to assassinate the President using sarin. The article also cites a passage in the cult's periodical Vajrayana Sacca in January 1995 that "it would not be strange" if Clinton were assassinated. The article asserts that the Japanese police interpreted this passage as an "assassination notice."
	Shukan Gendai article also raises the possibility of Aum "linking up" with other anti-American groups to "carry out the deed."
