RAUL ((COOKE)), A LEFTIST MEMBER OF THE RULING PEOPLE'S NATIONAL PARTY (PNP) NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, SAID THAT PRIME MINISTER MICHAEL ((MANLEY)) WAS AWARE OF EFFORTS BY LEFTIST ELEMENTS OF THE PNP, INCLUDING THE PNP YOUTH ORGANIZATION (PNPYO), TO ORGANIZE AN ANTI-AMERICAN DEMONSTRATION AT THE U.S. EMBASSY IN KINGSTON TO COINCIDE WITH THE VISIT OF U.S. VICE PRESIDENT TO JAMAICA. MANLEY AGREED WITH THE PRINCIPLE OF THE DEMONSTRATION BUT WANTED TO INSURE THAT THE ORGANIZATION OF SUCH AN ACTION WAS NOT DIRECTLY ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE PNP. ((KNIGHT)) FOR PRESENTATION TO THE VICE PRESIDENT. THE PAPER WOULD URGE THE U.S. GOVERNMENT TO RESTORE THE US\$25 MILLION IN ESF FUNDS OR FACE THE POSSIBILITY OF REDUCED COUNTERNARCOTICS EFFORTS BY THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA, DUE TO A LACK OF FUNDS.
