Alleged Illegal Domestic Activities

(Project MOCKINGBIRD)

- 1. Reference is made to the request of the Associate Deputy Director for Administration for information concerning the identities of members of Congress who were in telephonic contact with either Scott or Allen during the course of our coverage of the latter two individuals.
- 2. This is to advise that a thorough search of available Project MOCKINGBIRD materials reflects the name of one Congressman, John McCormack, Democrat from Massachusetts, as having been in telephonic contact with Scott on 26 March 1963. This is the only record which reflects telephonic contact by a member of Congress.
- 3. Attached is a Xerox copy of the log which includes the call from Representative McCormick to Scott. Neither the tape nor the complete transcript is available.

SUBJECT : Project MOCKINGBIRD

- 1. Project MOCKINGBIRD was a telephone tap in 1963 of the homes and the office of Robert S. Allen and Paul J. Scott, syndicated news columnists whose columns appear in the Northern Virginia Sun newspaper. A summary of the Project was previously furnished to your office.
- 2. In compliance with your request, the following additional information is attached:
 - a. Tab A consists of reports described in the Project summary previously furnished to you as based on information provided to the reporters by specific representatives of the Senate and Congress. Where available, telephone tap logs pertaining to these reports are attached to the report itself. It should be noted that copies of the transcripts of the conversations upon which the reports are based are also attached to the reports.
 - b. Tab B consists of telephone tap logs showing actual conversations between either Robert S. Allen or Paul J. Scott and members of the House of Representatives.
 - c. Tab C consists of telephone tap logs of, or where available, transcripts of conversations between Scott or Allen or others wherein a member of the Senate or Congress are mentioned as a source of information.
- 3. For your information, Adam, referred to in the attached logs and transcripts, is reporter Allen, and Samis reporter Scott. It should also be noted that the Office

of Security Project MOCKINGBIRD files, in addition to data previously furnished to your office, contains, for the mest part, logs of telephone conversations with a brief indication of the conversation content, but the files do not contain either the tapes of the conversations or a complete transcript of all of the conversations.

- 4. There are numerous inferences in the telephone tap logs to Congressional sources of Scott and Allen, but there are no transcriptions or tapes available to substantiate this. A sample of this type of log is attached as Tab D. In the entry 1410-32 hours, a person identified as John could possibly be Representative John McCormack. Further in this log entry, a reference is made to Representative Michael Peighan implying that he is providing information, however, there is also the possibility that the information emanated from other sources. Without actual tapes or transcripts, no deductions as to sources relative to this type of log entry can be made.
- 5. Please advise if you desire any further information concerning this matter.

ASSASSINATION OF CASTRO

President Kennedy in news conference with Maryland-Delaware newspaper editors indicated that there is unrest in Cuba and that Castro might be assassinated.

Senator Hubert Humphrey indicated to SAM upon his return from Costa Rica that there had been some discussion about the possibility Castro might be assassinated.

SAM calls ADAM's attention to AP story from Mfami over the weekend in which Manuel RAY's group agreed with the administration policy re no hit-and-run attacks on Cuba. The group states that unrest is growing and possible that Castro would be assassinated.

SAM states that these, all coming from different sources, could mean that something is in the wind. ADAM will include it in a column for Wednesday or Thursday (17-18 April)



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

has advised that during a recent conversation between SAM and ADAM, SAM indicated that he had talked to Representative Wilbur D. MILLS, (D), Arkansas, the Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee, about the matter of foreign aid to Yugoslavia. He stated that he learned that a "real fight" between the Congress and the Administration was in the wind and that Ambassador George Kennan would testify before Congress upon his return from Yugoslavia.

SAM stated that he and MILIS will assemble all the intelligence on what the Soviets have done and are doing in Yugoslavia. This information would be used in targeting witnesses before MILIS! committee on the Yugoslav aid matter.





has advised that during recent discussions between ADAM and SAM the following points were noted:

- a. ADAM told his good-friend Mrs. Beehan that he had been visited by a man from CIA, an old Army friend, Stanley. (Col. Grogan). He told Mrs. Beehan that through certain newsmen Administration circles were taking pot-shots at Mr. McCone and that Mr. McCone was concerned that they (the Administration) were planning to "unload him or kick him upstairs
- b. Col. Grogan contacted ADAM's secretary and gave her two unclassified references he had spoken to ADAM about. One was on Defense Department appropriations and one was on a Vietnamese disputing Warren Unna's story (Unna's story per SAM was an administration leak)


THE ALLEN-SCOTT REPORT

WASHINGTON-A House immigration subcommittee is challenging Atty. Gen. Robert Kennedy's decision that some 250 descendants of a Russian sect living in Turkey be allowed to settle in the United States.

The legislators, headed by Rep. Michael Feighan ID., O.J. are questioning both the attorney general's judgment and authority in permitting this band of Old Believers, a sect that split from the Russian Orthodox church in the 17th century, to come here.

The group is slated to arrive in June under the auspices of the Tolstoy Foundation of New York, unless the administration's plan is upset by

the House committee's investigation. A showdown on the case is due this week when Abba P. Schwartz, the state department's administrator of security and consular affairs, appears before the committee to explain the Kennedy administration's action.



Schwartz was summoned after an exchange of correspondence with the attorney general revealed that Schwartz was the key official behind the move to bring the Old Believers to this country.

Robert Kennedy, who also will be interrogated, wrote the legislators that he granted the sect special asylum under section 212 [d] of the immigration and nationality act because of "very persuasive reasons outlined by the state department" in a communication from

The attorney general claimed the sect's members, descendants of a band of 5,000 Old Believers who left Russia more than 300 years ago to live in Turkey, are under heavy pressure by Russian agents to return to Russia.

About 1,000 of the sect returned last Septemera but reportedly are unhappy. Since all admissions under section 212[d] are temporary and for emergency cases,

Robert Kennedy indicated the administration later would seek specific authorization from Congress to give the sect permanent residence.

In grilling Schwartz, the lawmakers will seek answers to questions they put up to Robert Kennedy but which he sidestepped by referring them to the state department. Foremost of these is whether the granting of this special asylum is a prelude to bringing other Russian groups to the United States, particularly from Latin America and Canada.

The Feighan committee raised this possibility in a letter to Kennedy, as follows:

"It is noted that the Tolstoy Foundation report forewarns of similar developments among other Russian emigre groups settled in Latin America, particularly Brazil, where the Russian emigre groups are clamoring for emigration to the United States. Obviously, this gives rise to the question whether a favorable determination on the 'Old Believers' in Turi key will produce a chain reaction of de terminations in response to the clamor of other Russian emigre groups.

"Another related consideration is the case of the Dukhobors, a Russian religious sect residing in Canada. They are known as 'spirit. wrestlers' and have much in common historically with the 'Old Believers.' Their collectivist customs and tendency toward public nudist demonstrations have caused tensions between them and the Canadian government in recent years.

"They, too, have been the targets of soviet pressure to return to the homeland and some members of the sect have in fact returned. In light of these tensions and the pressure of Russian agents, does it follow that this sect will also, be granted asylum in the United States?"

The legislators also want specific details on the number of the sect who voluntarily asked for emigration and those the Tolstoy Foundation "recruited" to come to the United

has advised that during recent discussions between SAM and ADAM, ADAM brought up the subject of the New York Herald Tribune story about the recall of 300 top Soviet intelligence operatives following the Penkovsky exposure and trial. He mentioned that the author of the article, Jim Warner, is a desk man, not a regular reporter, and wondered how Warner could get such a story.

SAM explained that there is one group in CIA which has been having private sessions feeding the material out to the press. He indicated quite strongly that the information coming from CIA was "bunk." He stated that he has collected the various stories. He mentioned that Eli Abel of NBC had it first, Charles Bartlett had it second, and the Herald Tribune had it third. ADAM recalled that Joe Alsop had printed a "razzledazzle" story on it also.

SAM stated that he had checked into the stories and found nothing to them. He indicated that the stories, including the newspaper-promotions of Penkovsky were all planted.

SAM stated that he had talked with Representative Leslie C. ARENDS, (R), Illinois, a member of the Special Subcommittee on National Intelligence Agencies. SAM stated that he was going to provide ARENDS with some material so that ARENDS can give Mr. McCONE notice to testify. ARENDS would then "sound out" Mr. McCONE on this matter.

As a side note, informant advised that ADAM indicated that he had seen Jim Warner only last week and that Warner was unhappy and had been complaining how he had been passed over many times during his 20 years with the Herald Tribune and Warner's complaints that other reporters are allowed to write columns and he still covers odd jobs.

That's the only thing. I'll get the name of the union and everything and it'll make a little...

It'll make an item. Joe Keenan didn't know anything but he said he would try and make some inquiries. He said they had no contact. He's with the Machininsts, electricians rather, hosaid they had no contact but he would see if he could...he didn't think much of...what's the head of the steel union?

version, see. They have, we now have definate evidence, they have modified they've got a modified version of the SA-2 and the SA-3, which can knock down short range halkintic balistic missiles. Now the only reason they can't knock down longer range is because they haven't got the radar tuned in to it yet, see. And now the same thing like a, so what do you do. You establish a tracking station in Cuba, you pick up and you get a fix on these things, then you radio this information to a control center in Moscow who then sends it to the missile site. And this is a matter of...

Seconds!

...seconds here, and then they can zero in with this thing. Now this is what's got the, why they set up that special sub-committee, is to see how, whether this link and whether the, waxwe're not delaying too long in putting our own in, because all this, they're going ahead with the refinement of their SA-2 and 3 rather than going to a new missile like we are. And I sat down with two people who know this radar thing backward and forward to be sure there was, to be sure; that this thing was very feasible, and they said this is the way this stuff works.

Well, I think that just a terrific story, when you got the pieces put together that Russia has made Cuba into a powerfull anti-missile base.

Outpost.

Outpost, huh. Whateveryout you want to call it, a base, outpost, ah, it's a base, it isn't an outpost, it's a base that's what it is.

They have one picture which shows a different type SA-2 than those they had, taken in this last parade down there, and they have never seen one of these modified ones up close and they believe this it it., because of the different type must new fins put on the 3rd stagem and maybe they're down there testing this thing out now, but the actual missile would still be in Russia, but the communications system wouldbe in Cuba.

Well, I think that's a terrific story. That's a hell of a story

And here they set up this special ...

That would explain their keeping all these troops down there and all these SA-2's and 3's or whatever the hell they are.

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aggression is established. (Sounds like he wask reading this last sentence). There's about seven if s in theire, you got to have firm evidence, and direct aggression, you see, and then you got to go through the damm CAS. I took this here as a basic basic thing from which our whole policy is formulated.

I heard Hotlett from 10 o'clock from down in Exect Costa Rica, the CBS guy, and hesaid that there's nothing going to be done, nothing of any real significance. This high-flown talk. He said they may, Kennedy may promise them some economic aid but he said this is just good-willing and, he didn't use the word grand-standing but that's what the idea is. 

Question #1 - Who approved it?

There is an indication in a summary of the Project contained in our files (Attachment 1) that the Director of Security received a requirement from the DCI to attempt through investigation to determine the identities of the source or sources of classified information to the two Dewinen.

it was recommended to the DCI that telephone monitoring would be the most productive. With the approval of the DCI, according to the summary, around the clock telephone monitoring of each home and their joint office was conducted. There are no memoranda available documenting the operational approval or direction by signature.

Question #2 - How high up the line of approval?

Question #3 - When we went to Attorney General -- What form did it take? Who? Spoken word -- formal?

Answer:

There is no formal memorandum on file documenting or substantiating the fact of a briefing of the Attorney General: however, there is mentioned in the attached unsigned and undated summary of the Project that the DCI briefed the Attorney General, the Secretary of Defense and the Director of the Defense Intelligence Agency.

Question #4 - How was McHamara approached? What was Secretary McMamara's reaction?

ARSWOT!

As indicated in the attached unsigned and undated summary of the Project, but with no other substantiating decumentation, the DCI briefed the Secretary of Defense.

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Question #5 - How did we approach the telephone company?
Answer:

The files do not reflect this information.

Question #6 - How did they or we do it?

Answer:

The files do not reflect this information.

Question #7 - Do we still have the tapes or transcripts or take?

Answer:

There is a volume available containing logs and tape transcriptions from March to June 1963. (NOTE: The attached summary of the Project reflects that the Project began in March 1962 and ended in mid-June 1962. This is at variance with the dates of the logs and transcripts cited.)

Question #8 - Who did we identify that Allen and Scott have contacts with?

Answer:

A list of contacts developed at the time of the Project are attached. (Attachment 2)

Question #9 - What names are on the tapes?

Answer:

The tapes are not available, but there are available voluminous transcripts documenting telephone conversations and containing a variety of names. (Attachment 2)

Question #10 - What leaks led to surveillance action?

Answer:

It would appear that attached summary of articles would seem to be the type of information which led to the surveillance, but there is nothing in the files to substantiate this. (Attachment 3)

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It is worth noting that the State Department Policy Planning Staff, when it was headed by Robert BOWIE in 1956, was a favorite target of MORRIS because of BOWIE's association with Owen LATTITORE. In addition, ALLEN's column of November 6, 1961 stated that the National Security Council policy of U. S. aid to Yugoslavia was written by Robert BOWIE and that approval of that National Security Council order of July 18, 1956 was predicated on a CIA report prepared by Robert AMORY and Sherman KENT.

The U.S. aid to Yugoslavia is currently a top target of the extreme right wing and particularly those Texas elements who are opposed to Yugoslav jet pilot training at an air base in Paris, Texas. As a result of these protests, further pilot training was terminated in mid-December 1961 at the request of a Yugoslav Defense Ministry official.

In addition, it is worth noting that Rober AMDRY has been a favorite target of the extreme right wing who have quoted him as saying in the past that Red China should be recognized and seated in the U. N. A copy of ALLEN and SCOTT's article is attached as Attachment B.

8. SCOTT and ALLEN in their columns have stated that Cord MEYER is in charge of unvouchered funds in CIA and had spent over four fillion dollars in the past year; that Mr. McCONE was disturbed at Cord MEYER funding Socialist conferences in Europe; and MEYER's background was set forth in the column impressing the fact that he was formerly head of the United World Federalists.

It may or may not be relative that Cord MEYER in 1954 furnished a loyalty affidavit in Jessie McKNICHT, a State Department official then under investigation. McKNICHT at that period was a target of investigation by Robert MORRIS who, at the time, was Executive Director of the Senate Internal Security Committee.

It is also noteworthy that MEYER's name and his connection with United World Federalists and CIA have appeared in Facts Forum, a text published and put out by H. L. HUNT, Texas oil man, and Blair more, both active in right wing circles.

- 9. SCOTT alleged that "some of the CIA estimates on East Germany were poor ones particularly in view of what has happened in East Germany". Further investigation will be required on this allegation.
- 10. SCOTT said that he had read the executive session testimony of General Bedell SMITH in which SMITH, according to SCOTT, claimed that CIA had been penetrated.

What SCOTT was referring to was General SMITH's testimony of October 13, 1952 before the HCUA in which he stated that the Agency must assume that it is penetrated and work from that premise, and second that there had been

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some agent type operation overseas which had been found to be Soviet intelligence controlled. These are the statements which General SMITH made in the open session. It is not known whether testimony was given in executive session, but it seems quite clear from the open session testimony that executive session testimony, if any, would not have been beyond that just described.
