SUBJECT : Project 63

1. Following receipt of your memorandum of February 1 we had a series of conferences with Joe Koepfli and with Col. Heckmeyer, the Director of JIDA. Our cable to you was the result of a discussion of top level within the Agency as to what action the Agency itself might take with JCS. In the meantime, Koepfli, through the Office of the Deputy Under Secretary of State, made an approach to the Joint Chiefs of Staff, and as a result of that, the TS cable to HICOG which you have undoubtedly seen was sent out. In view of the fact that we have had no further word from you we assume that adequate coordination with the Team under Lt. Col. Crabbe has been effected in Germany.

2. You may or may not have seen a TS memorandum from Heckmeyer to Nordstrom dated 20 February 1952. If you have not seen it, it would be worth your while to try to get a look at it through Nordstrom.

3. Please keep us advised of any changes in the status of Project 63.
