: Project 63

- 1. Following receipt of your memorandum of February 1 we had a series of conferences with Jos Rospfli and with Col. Heckemeyer, the Director of JIMA. Our cable to you was the result of a discussion of top level within the Agency as to what action the Agency itself might take with JCS. In the meantime, Scopfli, through the Office of the Deputy Under Secretary of State, made an approach to the Joint Chiefs of Staff, and as a result of that, the IS cable to HICOG which you have undoubtedly seen was sent out. In view of the fact that we have had no further word from you we assume that adequate coordination with the Teas under Lt. Col. Crabbe has been effected in Germany.
- 2. You may or may not have seen a TS memorandum from Neckemeyer to Wordstrom dated 20 February 1952. If you have not seen it, it would be worth your wills to try to get a look at it through Nordstrom.
- 3. Flease keep us advised of any changes in the status of Project 63.
