MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT : Psychochemical Agents

1. This morning of 31 May 1956 I was called to the office of Mr. [redacted] L.S./C/S, for conversation on the subject of psychochemical agents. Mr. [redacted] stressing the security aspects of the problem recognized the need of the CI section for information on psychochemicals in relation to chemical warfare and within the limits given in my memorandum of 17 May 1956.

2. I was requested to talk with Dr. [redacted] Chief Medical Division, and then with Dr. [redacted] Any future requirements were to be discussed with Dr. [redacted] and on occasion with Dr. Young, however, submission through regular channels or as a joint IAD-aid requirement.

3. In response to a direct question, Mr. [redacted] stated that Dr. [redacted] could have knowledge of a CI agent of this type (specific, for field use). In other aspects of the subject, such as mechanism, effects, and use (within the limits cited in para. 2), only I am authorized information in the section.

4. Later the same morning, Dr. [redacted] briefed me on the subject.
