ACTION REQUIRED: Please advise whether Xenia GLOWACKI should be hired by PBCHORD.

1. [] [] advises that PBCHORD has received approval from PBAFFIRM to hire Xenia *GLOWACKI (DOB: 19 Nov 1898; POB: Kamenetz, Podolia, Ukraine). [] [] asks that Munich Base be sure to call to Headquarters attention certain information which is available on Xenia GLOWACKI's husband, (Dr.) Boris Bogdan GLOWACKI. This information has been transmitted in EGMA-29215.

2. Munich Base has also obtained the following reply to a trace request addressed to ODOPAL: "Undated information at this office indicates that Xenia GLOWACKI, born 19 November 1898 at Kamenna, Poland, of Russian parents, was on 16 March 1951 rejected for immigration to the United States under Section 13 of Public Law 774. (B-2) Subject is the wife of Boris-Bohdan GLOWACKI, a reported blackmarket operator, imposter, and possible Polish agent, who in 1952 was reported to have extensive contacts among members of the Orthodox Church, the Border Police, and the Bavarian Government, and who was reportedly interested in identifying personalities that go to Poland on positive missions for the Western intelligence agencies. (UNEVALUATED)"

3. [] [] asks whether, in view of this information, Headquarters feels that PBAFFIRM's approval to hire may be observed.
