Prominent emigre, political figure, and journalist. Editor, writer, lecturer and administrator. Active in church affairs. Earlier commercial and educational experience. Associated with us since 1953.

2. KHOMYAKOV, Genadii; born 1906 in Stalingrad
(HOMJAKOW)

Editor and writer. Higher education (economics). Numerous published works. Wide journalistic experience. Former scriptwriter for VOA. Presently editor of Mosty.

3. DANILOV, Grigorii; born 1919 in Ukraine

Post-war emigre, fluent Russian and German and fair knowledge of English. Higher technical education, military experience. Particular administrative and commercial talent, experienced in personnel and welfare work. Has handled correspondence, and functioned as deputy to #1 above. Associated with us since 1954.

4. KOLYUZHNYI, Yevgenii; born 1914 in Gomel, Byelorussia
(KOLUSHNY, Eugen)

Journalist and administrator. Runs the radio section of TsOPE, including writing, editing and announcing. German not good. Associated since 1956.

5. BELOUSOV, Sergei; born 1902 in Moscow

Presently representative of TsOPE in Madrid and associated with Russian department of Spanish National Radio on freelance basis. Holds German passport. It is not yet known whether he will try to remain in Spain or will return to Munich.

6. ARBUZOV, Aleksandr; born 1928 in Yugoslavia

Office assistant, limited experience with printing and radio, electrical skills. Has received some radio training from RL employee Yevgrafov.

7. DOBARENKO, Konstantin; born 1895 in Minsk

Writer and part-time editor.

8. KIVKOV, Georg; born 1897 in Warsaw

Part-time employee only. Excellent writer.

9. PERFELYEV, Aleksandr; born 1889 in Tschita, USSR

Most useful in the field of satirical prose and verse (feuilletons, etc.). Also good typist and office assistant. Health often not too good, so may be unable to work full schedule all the time.

10. VASILYEV, Pavel; born 1909 in Orel
(WASILJEW)

Laborer and errand boy.

11. KISENKRAFT, Nina; born 1923 in Leningrad, USSR

Secretary and radio announcer. Good speaker.

12. YEVGRAFOV, Margarita
(JEWGRAFOV)
Typist.

13. MARTINSEN, [unclear] born 1899 in Tallin, Estonia
Excellent secretarial and clerical worker. Also knows Estonian.

14. NEIMANIS, [unclear]
Parttime [unclear]. Experienced in field of commercial distribution
of publications. U.S. citizen, retired, father of Orest Neimanis
whom we understand is or will be employed by RL.
