(U) Information on file indicates Sebastian Ignatius RANNER, born 18 June 1905 in MUNICH, was arrested by US Forces in REGENSBURG on 26 May 1945 and charged with having been the Chief of Gestapo in REGENSBURG. SUBJECT was interned by US Forces until circa April 1946, at which time HE was extradited to Luxembourg. HE was subsequently tried and convicted of war crimes by Luxembourg authorities. SUBJECT was interned until 1950 when HE was released and returned to REGENSBURG. (B-2) No further pertinent information available. (This paragraph FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY)
