2. Although we have no official FJSTEAL installation in this city, many officers from the FJSTEAL Embassy in Rio de Janeiro visit this city on a weekly basis. We also believe that probably within eight months and possibly before the end of the year, an official installation of some sort will be opened here.
3. We would have particular interest in receiving any guidances on FJSTEAL operations and/or modus operandi in Latin America. We are now in the process of compiling some information received from [] [] concerning FJSTEAL activity here, and we have some indications from this that, if true, their methods here do not show the finesse and care for details that they should. Naturally, it is rare that one follows the "book" in all cases, and it is also possible that the information we have to report does not concern professional intelligence activity, but a variety of amateurish activity that would in no way reflect lack of professionalism on the part of the FJSTEAL service. However, the inherent and obvious lack of professionalism on the part of the average Brazilian police service, plus the general lack of concern and understanding of the average Brazilian of sophisticated intelligence activity more common in Europe, would tend to create a "relaxed" environment in which the opposition intelligence service could work. This could in turn lead to lax security or less professional activity on their part.
