(U//FOUO) The CIA Office of Inspector General (OIG) received information alleging that an Agency staff officer self-reported a Hatch Act Violation involving himself prior to the national presidential election of 2016. The Agency staff officer used his Facebook account to raise support for his preferred presidential candidate by requesting fellow supporters canvass, call, and donate to help his candidate get elected. The Agency staff officer also used Facebook to share official campaign information about his chosen candidate. The Agency staff officer advised that he did not engage in this activity during the workday. This information is being provided for your awareness.
