

Discussion with SA, J. Hinson on 15 Sept. 1947

1. Concerning the von KIMBERG evidence: The Prosecuting Attorney, Dr. LUTHI, has stenographic notes of the evidence given. This has not been protocolized but if it is of use to the American authorities in Nürnberg it is available.
2. The judgement passed by the Swiss Bundesanwaltschaft against the "Bund der ~~XXXX~~ Schweizer in Grossdeutschland" is available or rather that part of it which would be of use in the Nürnberg trials - in other words if the Nürnberg prosecutors would find it useful they can see what action was taken against the Swiss Nazis.
3. Re the Franz RIEDWEG case: This case comes before the Swiss Federal Courts the end of this year consequently the evidence against RIEDWEG is now in use in preparing the case and will not be available until the trial is over.
4. See attached - pg. 54 to 103 is the case against the extreme right elements (Nazis) in Switzerland - anything in those pages could be given the Nürnberg officials if they will indicate where their interest lies.
