Hans Ulrich Rudel, former German Nazi Air Force colonel, and the leading figure of the German Nazi junta in Buenos Aires, has spent the last week in Chile. He gave lectures severely criticizing the West German Chancellor Adenauer and his policy, and opposed West German rearmament. Clandestinely, he has been supervising the recruitment for the "Kampfbund," which is a cover for the Nazi junta. He also requested the pro-Nazi politicians in Chile to exercise pressure on the Chilean government not to carry out the Mutual Military Assistance Pact, which the previous Chilean regime had concluded with the US.
