- 1. Reference is made to your request dated 8 August 1951 for a Covert Security Clearance to permit Subject's entry into the United States and his training while in this country in connection with project BOULDER.
 - 2. A review of Subject's file reflects:
 - (a) Subject attended at least one meeting of the KPD, applied for membership in it and was active in it.

It has been reported that the KPD is the Communist Party in Germany.

(b) Subject was also reportedly a member of the Bandera Party.

It has been reported that the Bandera Party is an element of the Ukrainian Army of insurrection which is anti-Communist and operates in Germany and Austria.

- (c) Subject is believed to have been at a D.P. Camp under an assumed name.
- (d) Subject was rejected for immigration to the United States and was refused a visa.
- (e) Individual believed identical with Subject was placed on travel restriction list.
- 3. For the above reasons Subject is security disapproved for entry and training in the United States in connection with project BOULDER.
- 4. The Subject's case will be reconsidered upon the presentation to this effice of further facts concerning his background and activities.
