REFERENCE(S)	<p>1. We are considering the exploitation of [] (IDENTITY A) as a REDSKIN candidate. However, his status as a stateless refugee may present a problem in terms of his obtaining necessary documentation from the FEDREP, primarily a re-entry permit.</p> <p>2. Can you offer any suggestions regarding the steps he might employ to obtain a visa to the USSR? We send this request to you in view of indications that the Soviet "Committee for the Return to the Homeland", via the USSR Embassy in Bonn, may have assisted emigres living in the [] who have wanted to take a first-hand look at homeland conditions. [] reasons for visiting the USSR, if he accepts our proposition, will be of a compassionate nature.</p> <p>3. [] was asked to query his U.S.W.I.N.G counterpart about the formalities and proceedings necessary to obtain a visa to the USSR.
