(C) Information on file dated October 1955 indicates that Mychaljo RUDKO, aka Josef Schmitz, born 2 March 1917 at DTYIATIN, West Ukraine, was investigated in the WURKIBURG area at the request of DAB on an undisclosed date. The investigation disclosed no information which indicated that SUBJECT was, or had been, a member of the WURKIBURG KPD, or that HE had ever attended meetings of the WURKIBURG KPD. (B-2) Our records further disclose that RUDKO was the subject of a request for information regarding HIS eligibility for immigration to the United States dated 18 March 1956. (B-2) Available records disclose no further information on file that was developed subsequent to September 1955.
