(c) Information on file dated October 1955 indicates that Mychaljo RUDKO, aka Joseph Soltka, born 2 March 1917 at BYTIATYN, West Ukraine, was investigated in the WURKING area at the request of DAB on an undisclosed date. The investigation disclosed no information which indicated that SUBJECT was, or had been, a member of the WURKING KPD, or that HE had ever attended meetings of the WURKING KPD. (b-2) Our records further disclose that RUDKO was the subject of a request for information regarding HIS eligibility for immigration to the United States dated 18 March 1956. (b-2) Available records disclose no further information on file that was developed subsequent to September 1955.
