1. POB has informed us that the Karl RADL mentioned as having put (Dr.) Heinz Joachim GRAP in touch with [] is described in a Zipper trace as a former Kriminalkommissar and SS Obersturmfuehrer who was adjutant to SKOLZENT. He is said now to be with a textile firm in Frankfurt and to have married recently. POB believes that ZIPPER would have so stated if RADL were a Zipperite.

2. No traces on EPDT, inn, were available in POB files - Zipper files were not traced. V-5750 has used the alias ERT, and physical descriptions of EPDT and V-5750 tally fairly well, except for estimated ages. POB sent us a photograph of V-5750 from its files, which you may show [] if you so desire.

3. Please note that V-5750 @ KUEN, was BARNITZKE's agent leader, but is apparently not identical with the KUHN of the [] case.
