MEMORANDON FOR THE RECORDS

Subject:

Request for Cortain FRIB unterial by Private Individuals.

- 1. Golomel White, FBIB, called this afternoon and stated that the atterneys of P. Q. Wodehouse, the British writer who was intermed by the Hesis during the war and did serveral broadcasts for them, have approached the War Department with a view to obtaining recordings of transcriptions of Mr. Nodehouse's broadcasts in commention with the British author's efforts to clear his name.
- 2. The Mar Department's reply, which was being prepared for the Secretary's signature apparently stated that the Mar Department did not have princey segminance of the matter but that the recordings were on file in the Matienal Archives under FBIB central and that transcripts could, no doubt, be obtained from the GIG. Galonel White inquired (a) whether it was desirable for the atterneys to address the GIG directly in the matter and (b) whether the material, which is uncleasified, should be released.
- J. Investigation reveals that the Matiemal Archives is the prepar public repository for non-current natural released to it by the several agencies of the government and is the prepar recipient of an inquiry such as that make by Mr. Medakouse's atterneys. Since there are elegante measures within the Matiemal Archives for the control of the natural upon the releasing agencies have placed restrictions, and since there appears in this wase to be no objection to the release of copies of the material in question, it was agreed that Calenal Write would ask his Mar Department contest to exit mention of the CIO in the proposed letter and to suggest that the atterneys approach the Matiemal Archives direct.
