1. Subject is an American who came to France in 1934 after having been tried in the United States for using the mails to defraud. Subject lived in Monaco until 1943 where he collaborated with the Germans. Passport #CC8 was issued to him at Nice on 4 February 1933. He is supposed to have entered Switzerland in August 1943, staying with his wife, Mrs. Renée MAI, at the Hotel des Bergues, Genova, where he was last reported in April 1943.
2. Subject is president of the TOKALON cosmetics company, with main offices in Paris. A report of 1943 states that Subject got into trouble with the authorities in Paris for alleged fraud. Subject also has a soap and toothpaste factory in the back part of the Hotel Monte Carlo Palace at 89 Blvd. Princesse Charlotte in Monaco. Subject was well known in Paris and on the Riviera where he lived on a lavish scale.
3. Subject is reported to have obtained trade privileges from one Captain PRICHT of the German Board of Economic Affairs at Paris. Captain PRICHT apparently agreed to the sale of TOKALON products in occupied territories in return for Subject's engaging in certain undefined financial transactions for the Germans.
4. In 1940 a manager of Subject's company stated that Subject was a close friend of MUSSolini and that he held two Italian decorations. It is also reported that Subject is a commander of the French Legion of Honor and a member of the Order of the Queen of Italy. A report of 16 October 1943 stated that Subject was an honorary member of the Monte Carlo Peasant Group (etc).

5. Subject's associates include the following:

- a. Etienne LEANDRI - Well known gangster and major world character who worked for the Gestapo at Nice and was associated with CAREDEAU, MAI, and SABIANI. He was also reported to be in charge of European publicity for the TOKALON company and to be the licensed supplier of olive oil soap to the British Army. He was said to

act as courier between Nice and Paris where currency and valuables were turned over to the Germans. In May 1944 he was reported to be a director of TIKALON. LEANDRI is the lover of Subject's wife, Mrs. Renée HEAT. A communication from Bern of 26 January 1946 states that he is living at 6 rue St. Roche, Lausanne, and that his expulsion (by the Swiss) is under discussion.

b. Bernard HESSECK - Well known officer of the Paris Milice and formerly an agent of the Marseille Gaullists where he collaborated with SABIANI and CARBONNIER. Worked closely with the PPF and with VIRGIL. Reportedly subsidized LEANDRI.

c. Sirien RATTANI - Chief of Contrôle du Territoire du Sud under Vichy. For a time was a political refugee in Switzerland. After liberation was named Directeur Général des Contrôles, with an office in the Ministry of Interior.

d. Alphonse PAGE - An international crook and associate of the French gangsters CARBONNIER and SABIANI. More recently he has been reported as operating in Italy under cover of being connected with the French Sécurité Militaire. His crimes include blackmail, smuggling of arms and drugs, card-sharpening -- to mention a few. Reported also to have worked for the French Sûreté Bureau.

e. Gaston FOUREZ - Associated with the same gang as LEANDRI. Worked for the Germans on the Riviera during the occupation. Reported to have worked for the French Sûreté Bureau.

f. Paul GAUDRON et Sabiani - Marseille gangsters who worked with the Milice.

g. Rosa RICCIARDO - An Argentinian and ex-dancer, living at 25 Blvd. de la Gare, Casablanca, Morocco. Subject is her godfather and she reportedly visited him at Nice once a year for ten years, the last visit being in February 1944. A report of 1/46 states that she was arrested for dealing with the enemy and that she was intimately associated with Virgil HEAT and therefore bore watching.

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
