As of 1 September it seemed possible that stepped-up activity in the Chinmen area was merely a diversion and that the Chinese Communist build-up in Fukien was directed against Wuch'iu (N 24-00, E 119-28) and other lightly held Nationalist islands off Central and Northern Fukien. The Chinese Communist build-up near P'inghai (N 25-12, E 119-28) tended to substantiate this possibility.
