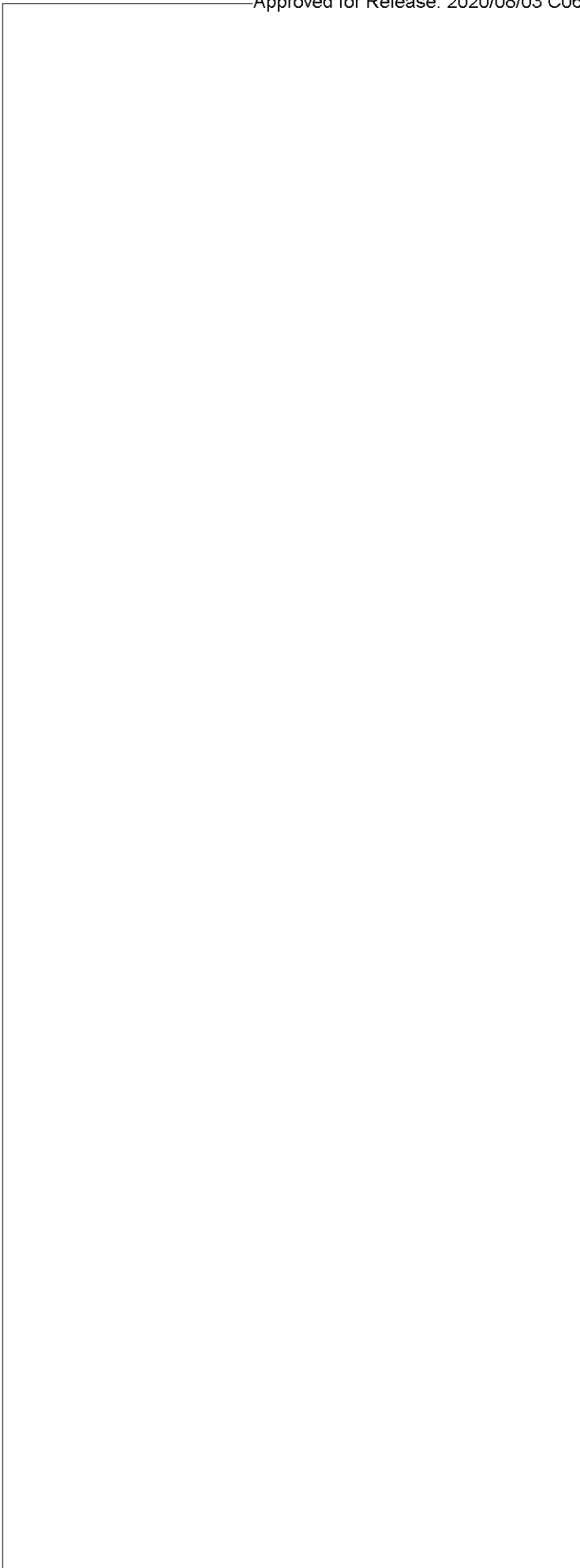
Executive Experts:

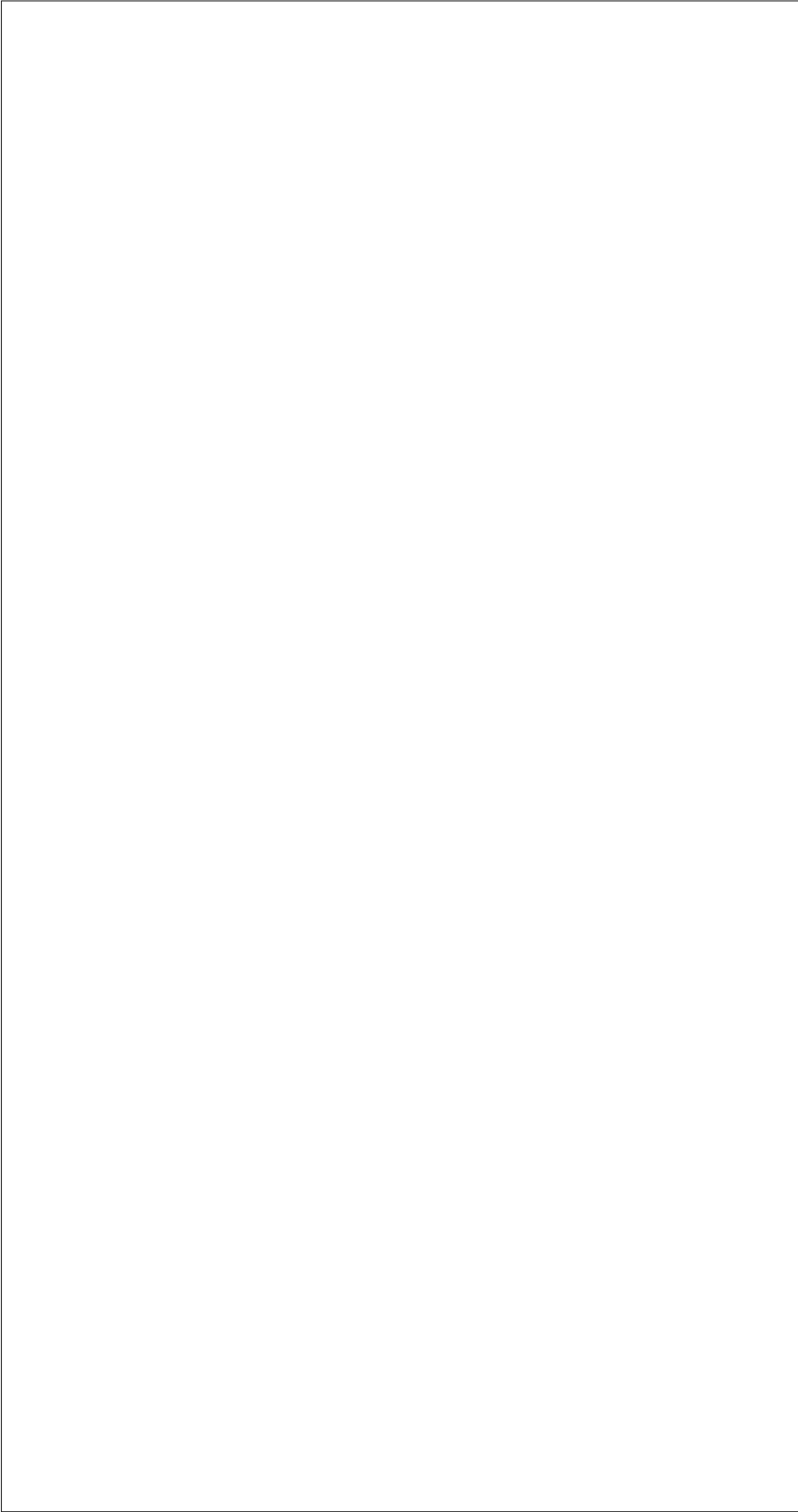

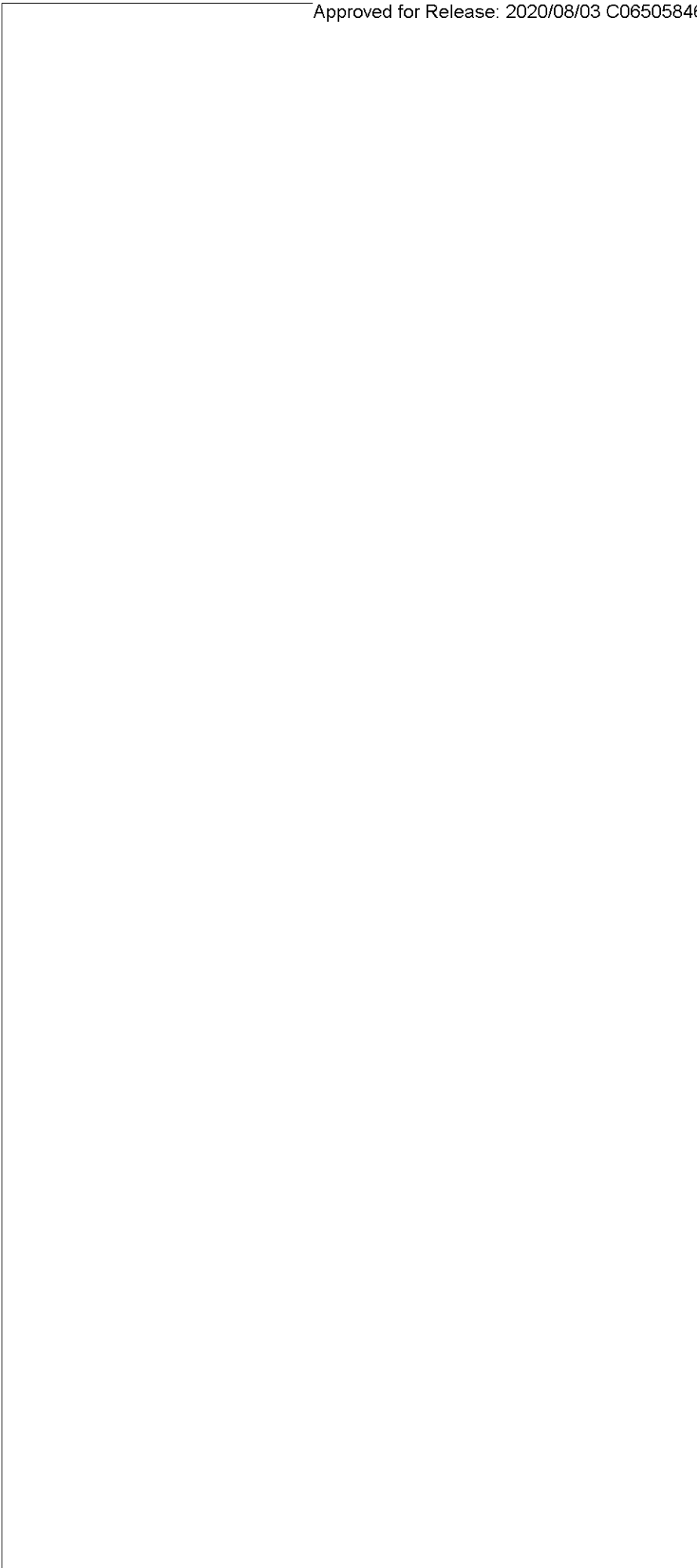

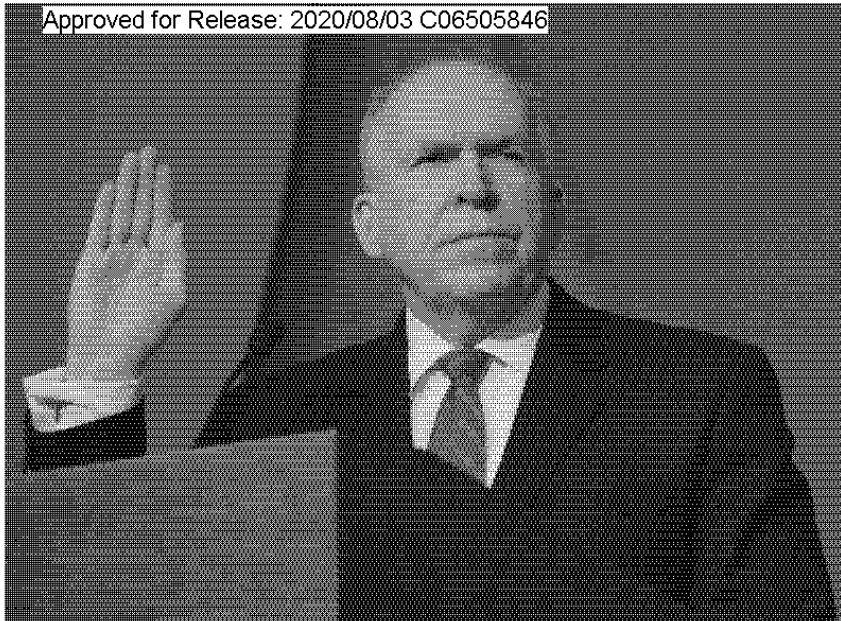
