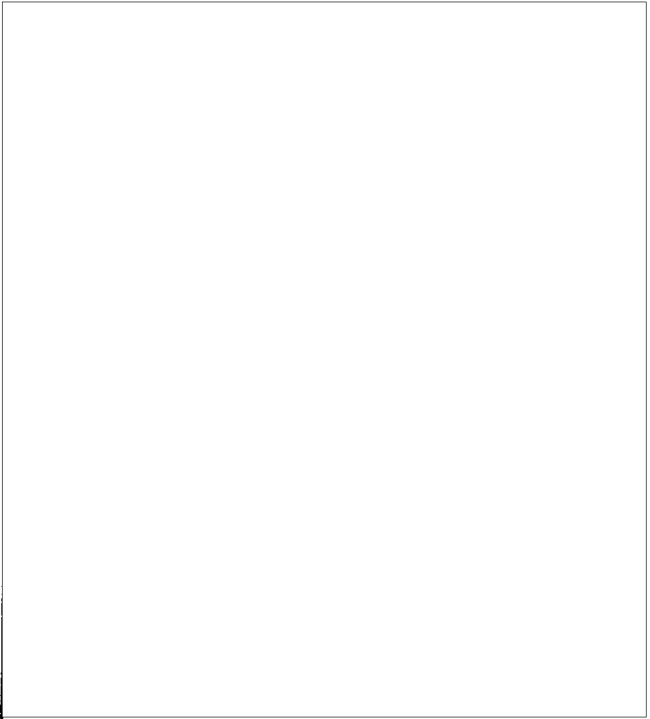
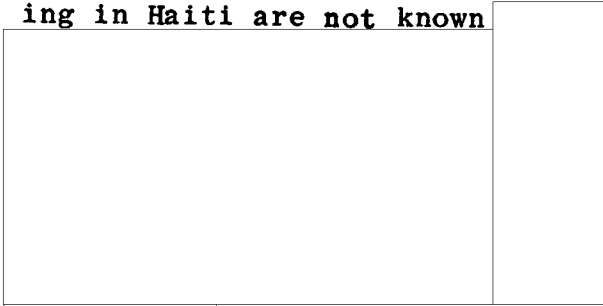
THE SITUATION IN HAITI

The situation in Haiti remains confused, but government concern is evident from a 22 July order establishing a full alert throughout the country.

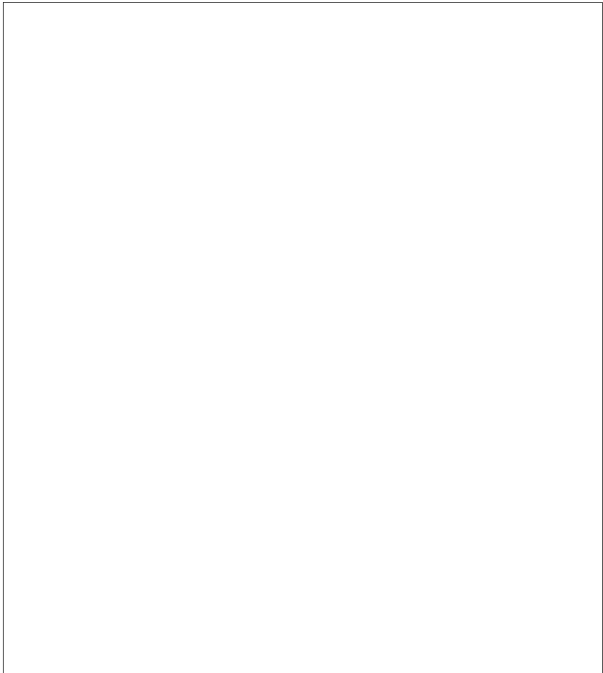
Although over 20 Haitians crossed the border into the Dominican Republic on 16 and 17 July, there is no indication that they are part of the original group of rebels which landed at Saltrou on 29 June. The exact number and location of rebels remaining in Haiti are not known

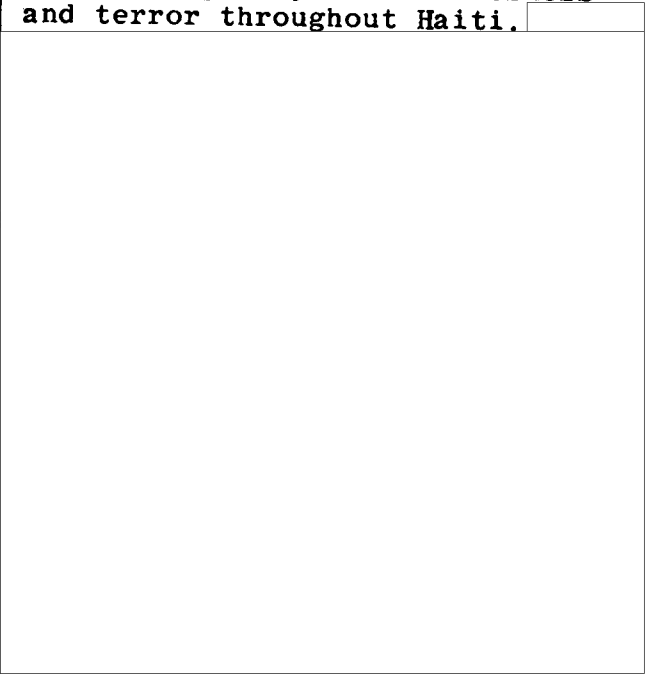
