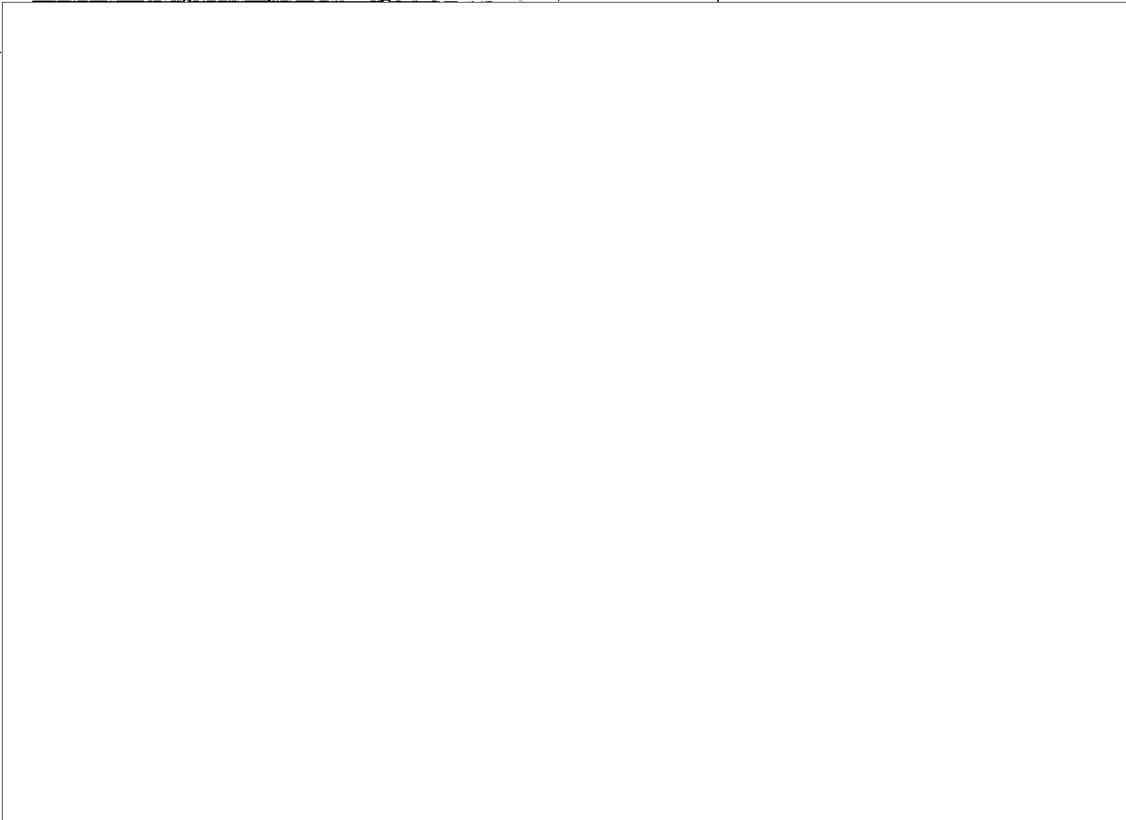

Following a pattern established in recent weeks, the Argentine Ministry of Interior announced on Friday the names of 325 persons detained under executive order. This brings to 2,993 the number of such prisoners acknowledged by the government. The US Embassy in Buenos Aires estimates that the current political prisoner population is about 3,747 and expects that the remaining 754 will be named in coming weeks.
