Subject: DR. SLAVIK AND THE EAST BLOCK CONFERENCE IN PRAGUE

1. The following information comes from a conversation held by HE 7 with

Dr. Adolf SLAVIK.

2. Dr. Adolf SLAVIK expects new directives for his work from the conferences at the East Block Conference in Prague. The latter was connected with a Kominform meeting. On Friday, 20 Oct. the Delegation of the Central Committee of the KPOe departed and will bring him his directives. SLAVIK indicated that it concerned the establishment of a tactic intended for East Germany and the Soviet Zone of Austria.

3. Dr. SLAVIK was especially impressed by the information he apparently received that Gestpo-Kriminalrat SANITZER and his "trusted colleagues" were in charge of the security measures at the East Block and Kominform Conferences. SANITZER was reportedly until the present being used as a teacher for the Anti-Sabotage and secret radio or the so-called radio play-backs (he was recently in Lemberg for this reason); the Prague assignment was the first practical job for SANITZER. SLAVIK saw in this a great change not only for SANITZER but for the entire Eastern-oriented group of the former Nazis.

4. Dr. SLAVIK stated that the mechanism for maintaining the public and party security in CSR is actually under the Russian control and also German because the Czechs are not regarded as reliable enough.
