

Here are the three items that you requested me to cover when I spoke to you after meeting Col. REID:

- a) George Young and his staff all operated in uniterm from their offices in the Schoenbrunn Palace when the SLS commenced operations in Vienna during the Summer of 1945. Young wore the uniform of a Lt. Col. until the Spring of 1946. Greengrocer and Greengrocer/1 both visited Young at his office where has was introduced to them as Lt. Col. Young of the D.I.S. Cyril Rollo also commenced operations in Vienna as a Major and in uniform. Later, in the Spring of 1946 he wore a civilian uniform with an ACABRIT patch and passed himself off as a member of the Civilian Control Unit. Sometime during 1947 he began to wear civvies.
- b) PETERIUNGER was formerly Greengrower/l's deputy. Greengrocer/l
  is responsible for PETERIUNGER's appointment to replace DURMEYER.
  The two men are on the best of personal friendship terms and G/l
  respects PETERIUNGER's administrative ability and initiative. He
  has oriticized PETERIUNGER for being naive in intelligence matters
  and also for being somewhat gullible in accepting information from
  untried sources on it's face value.

c) Greengrocer/1 thinks that the Soviet I.S. will employ

SANNITZER in an intelligence capacity if a shooting war starts

between the East and the West. SANNITZER specialized in d/a operations against the Soviets during the war. He was highly regarded by his superiors in the Gestapo for his success in controlling and playing back Soviet agents who operated with w/t sets in Austria.

Sannitzer was abducted from the prison at Stein during February by the Soviets.
