<p>Source: An Austrian government official</p> <p>Evaluation: B - 3</p> <p>"1. Dr. Adolf SLAVIK, born 24 March 1918 in Vienna, is an Austrian citizen and a Roman Catholic. A lawyer, SLAVIK is married and resides at Thalgasse 4/11, Vienna XV. After completing intermediate school, he enrolled in the law course at the University of Vienna. In 1940 he received the Doctor of Law degree.</p> <p>2. As a student, SLAVIK belonged to the Hitler Youth, but was active at the same time in the Austrian youth movement. In 1938, he was awarded the Hitler Youth memorial medal and gold decoration for his activity as illegal Hitler Youth leader in Simmering.</p> <p>....</p> <p>7. As early as 1945 Dr. SLAVIK had begun, along with similarly oriented persons, a secret organization for the aid and rehabilitation of arrested nazis and their families. While in prison he got in touch with Dr. TAVS (fmu), the convicted Nazi official, and Kraker-Semler (fmu), the former Hitler Youth leader. He established this contact through SANITZER (fmu), the former Gestapo police official now with the East German police.</p> <p>...."</p>
