Subject thinks that his various trips to Spain and Sweden are very suspicious and he is convinced the Warsinsky did spy work for the Germans. Warsinsky knows SCHELIENBERG, Brigadefuehrer in the SS Hauptsicherungsamt (active espionage). The last time subject saw Warsinsky was at Monte Carlo, July 25, 1944, when Warsinsky left for Spain.
