SURJECT: Views on AEDOGMA move to Ferie and involvement with UPBWING there.

MENT-5850 (IM-12863) which mentions UTENTHO's intent to continue contact with AEDOGRA/1 in Paris stimulated a closer inspection of the case by SR/2/CE, especially by the undersigned who had admittedly up to this time, practically ignored it. The tentative jet disquisting conclusions arrived at here were that if the French were not aware of Subject's UPSAING ties, the flap potential was indeed great, and KUBARK might well be involved in a 3 cornered Donnybrook. If, as seemed likely, the French were owere of Subject's UPSTING role and blessed ) connivence, with his presence in Paris, it suggested UPSVING-C RUBARK on the fuzzy end or the lollipop. Indeed, looking at the bigger picture through the long term lens but without the benefit of any knowledge of the operational climate in Paris, and in virtually total ignoresce of the detailed history of the case, the undersigned was hard put to justify Subject's move to Paris at all. Assuming, as appears logical, that Subject's sole access would be to the Ukranten catigre committy in Paris and Orthodox Church affairs in France, it is hard to believe that those targets are of such importance to MIRARK as to justify consitting the considerable talents of this agent plus whetever (considerable) handling and processing support by RDEARS and necessary to fulfillment of the task. In an attempt to obtain a conjuncts of opinion, the recent developments in the case were discussed with a number of knowledgeable persons in Boodquarters. The salient points which energed from these discussions are outlined below.

They brought up the possibility of broaching the matter to UPSWING in an attempt to clear the air, pointing out the sinister implications of Subject's contect with Col. SCHMALSCHLARGER, an UPSWING CR specialist.
