Danes Expelling Czech Diplomat

COPENHAGEN, April 26 (Reuters). — A Czech diplomat here is to be expelled for espionage, the Danish Foreign Ministry announced tonight.

The ministry said the diplomat, Josef Lensky, first secretary at the Czech embassy, had been engaged in illegal intelligence activity aimed at allied defense interests. He has been given until Friday to go.

The announcement gave no further details of Mr. Lensky's alleged activities, but said an unidentified foreign press correspondent said a West German had already been expelled from Denmark.

The press report said Mr. Lensky had been surprised by Danish police while he was in a hotel in the West German Embassy area.

The ambassador, who had earlier denied that Lensky had been involved in espionage, said the police had released Mr. Lensky after giving him a hearing for his detention.
