 - b. 168.4-13430 dated 20 April 1986 states that he speaks Remains and Hungarian and that he is possibly identical with the Absohr interpreter listed in the German Frimer as attached to Edo Samethrees.
 - e. Extracted information status that MSSICMAIN was a driver and sections for Organization 13 and for GV A. No later become an administrative essentive of GV A and of BV S. A later notation cays that subject was "Registrar of WEA/EV-18; until BV S was taken ever by GV C, he did all the typing, earling, and filing; ... hold (or may otill hold) a cover position with Akademischer Geneiuschaftworlag in Salaburg (GV A cover publishing firm)."

MOTE: The mission of PAO/UV-15 was the investigation of persons in Austria was were of operational interest to CATIME.

- d. An August 1956 deurseling report of an arrested Emmniam Intelligence Service official stated that SESTGMANN was a candidate for recruitment as a vest German Informant. Is 1953 his frequent letters to his wife Hortz (maiden mane entineen) and their two some (wee were students of that time) had come to the attention of the Security Police in Erasov where his family was living. The Runamian Intelligence Service gave Subject's vife a visa to visit her sister, Iran SEESLER, living in Mest Germany, in an attempt to contact and personde ESSIGNARY to come to knot Germany. Although Subject went to toot Barlin to receive a teleptone call from him wife, he refused to enter East Cormany. Mrs. EREIGHAMN returned to Rumania, where she was employed as a cambier in the cooperative store in Brasov, and applied for another visa. This report also contained becageous information on Subject. He had vorked as a journalist in Aumenia after his graduation from secondary nebeol. During World War II ESSIGNAMS had been elusely associated with the German Police in Kumania and bad left Rumania with the German Army. After the war until 1949 or 1950 Subject corresponded with his family from Austria, after that time from Munich. (Mis Munich return address w tailor shop comed by fau TELMARY. RESERVANT's family had been remiding in the farmer home of an individual named TELMARK who left Rumania for test Germany.)
- e. BOMA-37124 dated 10 Reptember 1956 contained reference to a discussion held with G SEMEMIAD who stated that since 1954 when RESIGNATE's family and neved from Russnis to Kest Germany (with the permission of both governments). Subject have been contacted governi times by unil and had been invited to visit East Germany and Bout Revlin.

NOTE: There is nothing in the file which explains the variation between 6 MERMEAND's information and the information given in puragraph 2 d above.

• SEQUENT mentioned that Subject, a Rumanian Volumentaries who had been an administrative officer cinco 1951, was originally thought to be a police official by the Rumanians who later indicated their nuaroness of his intelligence activities.

- *. Carded information lists Werner GORBRACHT, bern 26 april 1914, us a journalist. Other carded information states that he is an interrogator in the beasen area; that he is married to Elfriede (maiden name unknown); that he has three calleres.—Karim, Termiler, and Gerhild; and that he remided at Obermukh b. Rotenburg/F.
- b. EGLA-0280 dated a Hovember 1953 gave uin address as Frankfurt/Main, Fichtus::sass 12.
- c. BGLI-3737 dated 75 April 1964 one a report, which Rubject beload prepare, on CATIDE knowledge of Seine GLIESKE and his consections with CATIDE. (Information on SCARRES to contained in attachment 5.)
- d. EGLA-919% dated 1 June 1954 listed GORSHACKY, 6 GORSHACKY, 6 Being CASPAR, among members of CATIBE who were known to Gorhard KAPANMKE.
- - s.PEL-7473 dated April 1954 stated that hAPABHEE's mother-inlaw and sister were living in the East Zone. Zis eister's two sens were LCCLESCCR souriers.
 - b. Cabdim dated May 1954 states that Subject was a member of Kripe, the Deutsche Union, and the FDF. They also stated that he direpped by JAVELIE on 15 February 1953.

 - c. BQLY-253 dated 2 Jone 1954 stated that MAPABREE was a "Bans der Zukunft employee engaged in analysing and criticising auti-Communist propagated," and that he agreed to help REJ Burlin leaders prepare auti-Communist progagated. It also said that he "is evertly employed in CARROTT as Berlin representative in QEPERFUL, and that he is not chief of the Agent Hetters Section as previously resorted."
 - d. BRLN-7445 dated Pebruary 1954, classified "V.S. Officials Only," stated that CIS coverage revealed that CATIDE received information on 15 February that RAPANNES would visit Peter FISCHER who then resided at Berlin/Neukoella, Silbersteinstrance 32, on 16 February or shortly thereafter.

He was married to Christel (anides mass unknown) and they had two children whose mesos were unknown. His position was listed as interrogator. One betation reads "Propped 80 September 1954; received drop pay to 31 December 1954, thru transfer to Noc. 124/V. (See December 1954 payrell mote.)" to have no other information to confirm that he was dropped. A

 - h. BOSA-16391 dated 2 July 1954 replied that OSI requested traces on Subject in December 1953 from CIC and NID. It suggested that OSI be checked for further information.
 - c. EGLA-14578 dated 24 Jose 1955 stated that SCHLIEF and been a Seviet loss Source of CATINE and he had been dropped with projedice.
 - d. Carded information lists his wife as Charlette see HUMCHCOV, bern 10 May 1915.
- 4. The following information is synthable on Theoder SCHMINGREES
 - s. MGLA-4030 dated is June 1383 stated that Subject was being considered by CATIDE for a post with their KEDCAP tens.
 - b. EGLA-8488 dated 13 April 1954 requested a retrace since Subject was being considered for a neasitive againment. This dispatch stated that SCHHERENERG was graduated in 1914 from the German Gymnasium in Petersburg. From 1914 to 1917 he served in the Russian Army; from May to November 1918, in the German Army; sad after Revember 1918, in the White-Russian Army working under General STEPHANIE on intelligence assignments. Subject counci the Solid Cigarette Factory in Berlin from 1922 to 1948. In February 1948 after his Berlin graperty was destroyed during as air raid, SCHHIRESHES meved to his house in Klein-Hachsov, Sedenatrasse. In January 1953 he returned to West Berlin. He was employed under the cover same Hilat for three ments (during as unaposited period) by Hosequariors of the 7840 Hilliary Intelligence Detachment is Berlin-Schlenderf, Sophio Charlettenstrasse 45, as a Euseisn translator. Subject lived at Berlin-Schmargendurf, Diedesbeimerstrasse 11, c/o TRIKUR. Six vife and son lived in Beidelberg, Baussiantrasse 03.
 - c. MSCA-43961 dated 1 July 1954 stated that he was srepped without projecte since the mission for which he was employed was completed and his services were no longer required. He was considered suitable for re-employment. SCHEIRDERED held identity Document DPA 185/273/5. He speaks Gorunn, Eussian, and French. His description in ne follows. height 180 cm., weight 185 lbs., grey mair, blue eyes. no identifying marks.

- to held-base dates 2 may 1981 described SCHURACHER as follows: 180 nm. tall, blue eyes, thinning dark blood mair. Him home address is listed as livemere-idetracte \$5, hupertal, but he lived in Frankfurt. Since we had been a police official before world far II, he was automatically transferred to the 55 in 1984. Probably he is identical with the Sturmbashafueher SCHUMACHER listed in the Serman Primer.
- c. The attachment to MGLA-17517 dated 25 July 1957 states that Subject attended a Volvenchule and Oberresischule and received as Abitur. He was graduated from the University of Law and Becoming in 1952. After his war examination, be attended the Epocial School for Criminology. Until 1965 when be joined the Abuehr, he was a police official and had held the Funks of Lemnisons, primineirat, legicsungs- and Shorregierungsrat. SCHEMACHER's demanification intthe British Kome was not completed. Be speaks English and french.
- d. SGLA-734G dated 29 January 1984 gave Subject's address as Frankfurt/Enin, Am Rheideld 244 (1956).
- e. The attachment to MGLA-5561 dated 13 April 1954 listed Subject's address as Supports!, Neckelstrass 53. His wife is Elaboth (furner uses LIESEN) bern 11 Hovenber 1917 in Supports!. Their (or her) children are Ursula LIESEN born 9 Hey 1939 in Supports! and Echhert LIESEN born 94 January 1942 in Supports!, NCHMERCES holds N. F. NY IV 760090 s.
- f. An extract from BGLA-10017 dated 36 September 1852 stated that Subject, identified as Dr. SCHESET, former CE chief of a major CATES field base, and fallon under suspicion. "Eis field base suffered most periosaly from the long seige of arrests of CATES agents which received widespread publicity in the eastern press during 1953.... He, personally, was missed in the east press along with his exact job description.... Br. SCHESET was well known to Ludwig ALBERT, who probably provided the Seviets with the material used by thou in the Lill Harlone case. The Soviets snew the nest whitients details about him, and the Lill Harlone wierefilm directly implied that Br. SCHESET was a Soviet penetration of CATES." Subject was transferred to an unspecified staff job wader the direct supervision of UTILITY, who did not want him terminated.
