SUBJECT: Dr. OTTRUBA *ed*

1. Since the last report 26 April 1946, OTTRUBA has been to Munich twice. His "story" is that he is looking for an opportunity to settle down in the American Zone as a practicing physician. He has usually some American cigarettes for sale, but he limits his sales to two packs. Since he seems to have sufficient money of his own, he is obviously not a black marketeer but sells cigarettes in order to make acquaintances and friends. His UNRRA papers were issued to him in Erlangen.

2. During these last two trips his interest was running to the following questions:

- a. Travel opportunities for Germans into the other occupation zones.
- b. Whether the old "fight-divisions" have returned to the USA and their place taken entirely by second-class troops (occupation soldiers).
- c. Number of battle-trained American troops in the American Zone.
