SUBJECT: Election Note from Czechoslovakia

1. According to reports, a few days before the elections about 50,000 Czech families in Prague received letters stating that they had maintained close business contacts with the Germans during the war and could under certain circumstances be called to give an account of their collaborationist action.

2. This could be interpreted only as election blackmail.
